REGISTRATION AND FEES

Please register your child as soon as possible after receiving this letter as **there is a cut-off date for registration**. After you have paid the registration fee on Kindo your child will be entered into a team and you will be advised which team prior to the competition starting.

Please note: If we do not receive enough student registrations to make up a team we will not enter that team into the competition and you will be refunded your registration fee through Kindo.

UNIFORM

All children are required to wear the red Te Totara Sport Shirt which is separate from your child's everyday school uniform. You can purchase this through Direct Group, 115 Ellis Street, Frankton. COACHES AND MANAGERS
