
### **FUTURE SCHOOLING SPECIAL**

As you may well be aware, our school enrolment zone will shrink when the new Endeavour School for Year 1-6 students opens at the beginning of the 2015 school year. This newsletter will bring you up-to-date with what this means.

### New School Zone from the beginning of the 2015 School year

Our school zone will change to fit in with the new schooling at Endeavour School starting, as well as to accommodate growth in the area. The western boundary will be reduced back to Resolution Drive, the eastern boundary reduced back to Horsham Downs Road and north boundary reduced back to the line of the Waikato Expressway.

### The map below shows the zones from the beginning of the 2015 School year



What does this mean?

All current students enrolled at Te Totara Primary School at the end of the 2014 School Year are eligible to stay at Te Totara.

## SOME FAQ's

# My child already goes Te Totara and we will be out-of-zone for our younger child/ren to attend, what happens?

You are eligible to enrol all your children at either of Endeavour School or Rototuna School if you live in their school zone. You may also apply to enter the out-of-zone ballot for Te Totara for the 2015 school year, see information below.

### Why can't the younger brother or sister attend as of right?

The Ministry of Education has strict guidelines on enrolment and we are bound by these. Out-of-zone children do not count for building entitlement i.e. if the school has 850 children and 50 of these are out-of-zone enrolments then the school only has entitlement for 800.

### Can a student get into the school if they live out of the school zone?

Only if they are balloted in, or in extreme cases directed by the Ministry of Education

### What is Te Totara Primary School doing?

The Board of Trustees are looking to accommodate, if possible, younger siblings and children of staff in the 2015 school year. To help determine this, we urgently need to have Enrolment Forms in to the School Office to help with this process. Enrolment Forms are available from <u>Te Totara enrolment forms</u> or by visiting the School Office.

At the Board of Trustees meeting on the 29th August, the Board will look at the number of enrolments, the level of predicted student growth and determine how many spaces for out-of-zone students are available for the 2015 school year. This will be completed in September, allowing for lots of time for families to know what is happening.

# What about current students who are attending Te Totara and will move to Endeavour School when it opens?

If your child is moving to either Endeavour or Rototuna School Schools, then please contact the school <u>brians@tetotara.school.nz</u> as soon as possible and by 20th August please. We do understand if parents wish to take this option. This helps with our planning for out-of-zone students as well as for staffing levels for the school. The Ministry of Education is also conducting an online survey for the community to help determine where students are going to help all the schools with their planning. More details are likely in next week's newsletter.

### What about other schooling?

Two other state Schools are due to open:

- In 2016 a Year 7-10 Junior High School. This will start with all year levels
- In 2017 a Year 11-13 Senior High School. This will start with Year 11 and add a year level each year
- Both schools are located around 200 metres to the north of Te Totara Primary School.

# VISITING PRODUCTION FROM NZ PLAY HOUSE IN WELLINGTON

On <u>Wednesday 13th of August</u> there is a touring production visiting our school from The New Zealand Play House in Wellington. They will be performing a production called 'Rap-unzel'at our school. The play puts a twist on traditional fairy tales, and is specifically written for primary school aged children.

Watching this performance is a great opportunity for all our <u>Year 3-6 students</u> to observe a professional production, before they take to the stage in week ten for our production 'Pirates of the Curry Bean'.

### **ILLNESS AT SCHOOL**

We have begun the term with a number of students away with infectious illnesses including Chickenpox, Glandular Fever and Strep Throat. According to the Ministry of Health Infectious Diseases Guidelines:

### Chickenpox

- Early signs are a fever and spots with a blister on top of each spot.
- The child is infectious from up to 5 days before appearance of the rash until lesions have crusted (usually about 5 days).
- Time between exposure and sickness is 13-17 days.
- This disease is spread by coughing, sharing saliva (this is one of the reasons why we have no spitting at school) and sneezing and by direct contact with weeping blisters.
- Exclusion from school is approximately a week from the date of the appearance of the rash.

We also have one case of Glandular Fever at our school. Anyone at any age can catch Glandular Fever and symptoms are similar to the Flu with chills, loss of appetite, headache, fever, sore throat and swollen glands in the neck, armpit or groin. These can persist for several weeks or longer.

If you are unsure whether your child should return to school, please see to your family doctor.
