iPADS AT SCHOOL

An update on our Technology at School...

We have 100 of our School iPads coming off lease and they are about to be replaced with 150 iPad Mini's, giving our children greater accessibility to this technology. This is some undertaking and we will be working through this over the next month. They have to be configured and school apps loaded.

We are hoping to roll out a BYO iPad programme later in the year once we have got the school iPads going well. We are aiming to start with year 5 & 6 and work our way through the school. There are lots of challenges to overcome as we could potentially have well over 800 iPads using our system.

Our e-Learning team have been working hard behind the scenes getting everything organised and won't be launching until we are ready. We want to make sure we get it right.

Meanwhile, if you are considering technology purchases we recommend you consider iPads as this is the technology we will be using in the school.
