#### 2016 OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS

#### FIRST ENROLMENT PERIOD

Recently, the Board of Trustees released 50 out-of-zone spaces for the first enrolment period of **1st January 2016 – 30<sup>th</sup> June 2016**Applications have closed and parents have been informed of the outcome.

#### SECOND ENROLMENT PERIOD

Early in 2016, the Board of Trustees will look at the number of enrolments, the level of predicted student growth and determine how many spaces (if any) for the second enrolment period of 1st July 2016 – 16th December 2016. This process will be completed allowing lots of time for families to know what is happening.

A number of families have submitted outof-zone enrolments for the second enrolment period already, we will hold onto those. Further information will be placed in the newsletter closer to the time.


