
Sun 3rd July Te Totara Invitation Netball Tournament

SIBLING OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR THE PERIOD OF: 1ST JULY, 2016 TO 16TH DECEMBER, 2016

The Board of Trustees are looking to accommodate, if possible, New Entrant siblings and children of staff due to start school before between 1st July, 2016 and 16th December, 2016.

To help determine this, we <u>urgently</u> need to have all out-of-zone Enrolment Forms in to the School Office by **Friday 27th May** to help with this process. Enrolment Forms are available online from our school website or by visiting the School Office.

Shortly, the Board of Trustees will look at the number of enrolments, the level of predicted student growth and determine how many spaces for out-of-zone students may be available for the period of 1st July – 16th December, 2016. It is likely that 20 out-of-zone spaces will be available however; the exact number of out-of-zone spaces will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone. Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on our school website www.tetotara.school.nz

Parents of new entrant children who live within the home zone should also apply by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately.

More information will follow via the school newsletter. If a ballot is required, it will be held on <u>Wednesday 1st</u> <u>June, 2016</u>. Parents will be informed of the outcome by **Tuesday 7th June**, **2016** (3 working days later - Monday 6th June is Queens Birthday Holiday).

HEADLICE

Our Public Health Nurse has dropped in to see us and has some excellent tips on treating Headlice. She has recommended a product called "NitEnz" which is a natural shampoo proven to be very effective in eradicating headlice. It can be purchased from the supermarket. She urges that directions MUST be followed and a test patch conducted before applying.

We suggest to all our families to check your child/ren's hair on a weekly basis and wash hats regularly.

Please note: Children who are not treated may be asked to go home until treated.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

We are delighted with the large number of students who look really great by wearing their uniform in the correct manner. However, we have noticed a few students who are not complying with our Uniform Expectations and we ask your assistance with this.

ALL students are expected to be wearing their full correct uniform.

Students are to arrive at school and leave from school in their Te Totara Primary School uniform, **including footwear**.

- Uniforms are to be worn clean, neat and tidy.
- Students are encouraged to take pride in their school uniform and to wear it well.
- Hair is to be off the face, tied back if longer than the bottom of the collar, and be the natural hair colour.

- Nail polish and cosmetics are not permitted.
- Second hand uniforms may be available. Please see the notice board in the School Office for details.
- Any hair accessory is to be of a single school uniform colour red, white, black, green.
- Variations in relation to the Human Rights Act may be negotiated with the Principal.
- All pupils are encouraged to use sunscreen at home before school and expected to wear the regulation school hat while outdoors. No hat play in the shade.
- All uniform items should be clearly named.

From the beginning of Term 2, 2016 we will are expecting all students to be wearing their winter school uniform.

JEWELLERY

Items of jewellery can be easily lost or damaged at school. They may also cause injury to the wearer or other students. For safety reasons items of jewellery are NOT to be worn. The school accepts no responsibility in the case of loss, damage or injury.

However, students may wear:

- a) One small earring stud per ear.
- b) A watch.
- c) A necklace of religious or cultural significance to be worn underneath clothing.
- d) A Medical Identification Tag as required.

NAMING OF SCHOOL UNIFORM

It is not good enough to assume that your child will know that something belongs to them "because it has a black dot on the tag". If an item of clothing is found out on the fields it cannot be returned unless it is named. We go out of our way to identify and return lost property, but it is extremely difficult when clothing is not named.
