
TELL ME YOUR STORY EVENING WEDNESDAY 3RD & THURSDAY 4TH AUGUST, 2016

Students will need to look their best, so please ensure the correct school uniform is worn and that it is in a clean and tidy condition.

Soon after Photo Day your son or daughter will bring home an online slip with their unique **Shoot Key** detailed on it. When you log-in your personalised Shoot Key # will display all the photographs of your child, <u>including an</u> <u>individual photo</u>. It is then an easy process for you to shop on-line and purchase the photographs you want. If you place your order within three weeks of receiving your Shoot Key you will receive free delivery for your photo orders. PhotoLife has agreed to despatch all the orders back to the school and your child will bring their photographs home.

SATURDAY MORNING MUSIC CLASSES

The first session for Term 3 of the Hamilton Community Centre of Music is on <u>Saturday 30th July</u>. The centre is a charitable trust that's located on the University of Waikato campus in Hillcrest. It offers tuition in a wide range of musical instruments, for all ages (from 3 to retired) and ability levels. Because the classes are in group format, the fees can be lower than for private lessons (\$65/term for most instruments for children under 16). Classes run between8am and 12:30pm on Saturday mornings during primary school terms. The enrolment fee for an instrument class includes participation in any one of the following: an ensemble (string, guitar, flute or keyboard), our concert band, or the HCCM Sinfonia Orchestra.

We are now offering a Tabla class: \$95 for eight one-hour classes for ages 10+. Also available for children ages 3 through 12 is Music Makers. Based on the Orff-Kodaly principles of music education, these classes incorporate singing, movement and simple percussion instruments to encourage musical enjoyment and exploration. 
