# **CANCELLATION OF SWIMMING PROGRAMME FOR 2016 – INCLUDING SWIM SCHOOL**

As you will be aware, we have had some water quality issues with our swimming pool that has unfortunately affected our children's swimming programme.

Our staff have been working hard to try to remedy this situation however; the issues have had a significant adverse impact.

We have been unable to restore the pool to ensure smooth ongoing operation so we have made the difficult decision to close the pool for the remainder of the school year, through until the beginning of Term 1, 2017.

We feel very disappointed to have to take this action and do understand that you and your children will also feel disappointed.

Invoices for those students affected will be adjusted accordingly to reflect the cancellation of the swimming.

We are now focused on remediation action to ensure the pool is fully functioning for the start of the 2017 school year.

# CLASS PLACEMENTS 2017

We are currently working through placements for next year. We have been pleased that parents and students have had an opportunity to contribute to the process, it has helped.

- The class for next year will be available from **4.00pm Friday 9th December** on the Parent Portal, using the same login details used to access Learning Plans online.
- Teachers will talk with children about the arrangements for 2017 and answer any queries on Friday 9th December, so students have an opportunity to clarify any queries they may have
- On Wednesday 14th December from 1.30pm-2.00pm students will visit their new class and teacher. This helps our children know what is happening and to ask questions and build rapport with their teacher ready for 2017.

#### OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS PERIOD FOR 2017

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on our school website <u>www.tetotara.school.nz</u>

The Board has determined that <u>3 places for New Entrant (Year 1) students</u> are likely to be available to out-of-zone students whose 5<sup>th</sup> Birthday falls within the enrolment period of 1<sup>st</sup> March 2017 – 30<sup>th</sup> June <u>2017</u>. The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

The deadline for receipt of out-of-zone applications is **<u>3.00pm on Tuesday 31st January, 2017</u>** and should be addressed to:

Parents of students who live within the home zone should also apply by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately for next year. Students who live in the home zone are entitled to enrol at the school.

Applications from out-of-zone students will be processed in the following order of priority:

- a) First priority must be given to students who have been accepted for enrolment in a special programme(s) run by the school and approved by the Secretary of Education\*.
   \* This priority is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Ministry of Education
- b) Second priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school.
- c) Third priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a former student of the school.
- d) Fourth priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.
- e) **Fifth priority** must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the Board of the school, or a child of a member of the Board of the school.
- f) Sixth priority must be given to all other applicants.

If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot supervised by a Justice of the Peace, a Practicing Lawyer or a Police Officer in accordance under Section 11G (1) of the Education Act 1989.

If a ballot for out-of-zone is required, it will be held on <u>Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2017</u>. Parents will be informed of the outcome by **Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> February**, 2017.

### END OF YEAR CELEBRATION MONDAY 12TH DECEMBER AT 5.45PM

This is our annual event to celebrate another great year at Te Totara. Here is some information to help make it a great event:

- It is a school event, so children need to be in a clean and tidy uniform and will be together as a school and are under the control of school staff. Please leave your child with us; we will take care of them.
- Students will need to stay through the whole event.
- There will be very limited parking available at the school car park and none in the turning bay. It will be best to find a car park on a nearby street and walk.
- It is like a concert in a park so bring a picnic, a rug to sit on, something to eat and drink and enjoy a variety concert.
- We use the hill behind Ra and Earth as outdoor stages where children perform. Toilets are open in the Ra and Earth blocks.
- Pre-schoolers are welcome to use the playground away from the performers so they don't distract from the performance.
- Other children not involved in the school are asked to be respectful and if they want to play, then the court area is a good place.
- There are likely to be over 2500 people at the event so we strongly advise walking to the event.
- Please <u>NO</u> umbrellas as it blocks the view of people behind.
- We will have a "Paparazzi" section at the front for parents of those performing to use to get a good photo.
- If the weather is not good, we will postpone to Tuesday 13th December, same time.
- Notifications will be put on the school Facebook page, school app and the website.
- The event is weather dependent, so may be cancelled at the last moment, but we will do our best to let everyone know as early as possible.
- At the end of the event we will need to stagger people leaving due to Health & Safety, so please be prepared to wait a little time. Announcements will be made to help.

#### **ALLERGIES/MEDICAL CONDITIONS**

In the event of a medical emergency, if your child has a medical condition, is taking regular medicine/tablets or has an allergy (including sticking plasters etc.), please advise the School Office (if you haven't already), so we can amend your records accordingly.

We also have several children in school with allergies and we have procedures in place to keep these children safe, including not sharing food/drink, washing tables, and hand washing before and after eating. Thank you for your cooperation in these matters.

#### **SCHOOL SORES (IMPETIGO)**

Just a reminder to keep an eye out for blisters on exposed parts of the body, such as hands, legs and face. The blisters burst and turn into a sore with a yellow crust that gets bigger each day. The sores are itchy and spread easily to other parts of the skin. Impetigo is easily spread to other children and adults by direct contact with the discharge from infected skin. They are **highly contagious** and children are infectious until sores are healed. To avoid the risk of infection, please ensure all open sores are kept well covered. If you have any concerns, please visit your Doctor as antibiotics are required to treat Impetigo. For more information regarding visit:

#### CHICKENPOX

According to the Ministry of Health Infectious Diseases Guidelines:

- Early signs are a fever and spots with a blister on top of each spot.
- The child is infectious from up to 5 days before appearance of the rash until lesions have crusted (usually about 5 days).
- Time between exposure and sickness is 13-17 days.
- This disease is spread by coughing and sneezing and by direct contact with weeping blisters.
- Exclusion from school is approximately a week from the date of the appearance of the rash.

If you are unsure whether your child should return to school, please see to your family doctor. A copy of the Infections Diseases Guidelines can be found on the school website under "Infectious Diseases".

#### HEADLICE

Our Public Health Nurse has dropped in to see us and has some excellent tips on treating Headlice. She has recommended a product called **"NitEnz"** which is a natural shampoo proven to be very effective in eradicating headlice. It can be purchased from the supermarket. She urges that directions **MUST** be followed and a test patch conducted before applying.

We suggest to all our families to check your child/ren's hair on a weekly basis and wash hats regularly.

#### Please note: Children who are not treated may be asked to go home until treated.




