MAJOR BUILDING PROJECTS UPDATE-COURT COVER

As you may be aware our big project is the building of a court cover to allow for use all year round. This will allow for so many different activities for our children.

As the school is now 10 years old, it qualifies for funding from the Ministry of Education to ensure our school is a safe place and is fit for purpose. This involves the formulating of a five-year-plan, which we have been working on over the last six months. We have now completed this plan and it is now with the Ministry of Education, awaiting ratification.

As part of the plan we have included the building of the court cover, which is a significant expense. We are hopeful that that if funding is approved we can tender this out and get going on the work, but will have to wait and see what tender prices are like.

Our wonderful PTA have raised \$80,000 to support the project and we are all very, very appreciative of the work and support of the PTA and community. Our BOT have also allocated \$50,000 out of the capital works budget for the project. It is neat to see our BOT and PTA working together to help our children.
