### \*\*URGENT\*\* SIBLING OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS Enrolment Period of 1st July - 14th December, 2018

The Board of Trustees are looking to accommodate, if possible, younger siblings and children of staff in the 2018 school year. To help determine this, we urgently need to have Enrolment Forms into the School Office to help with this process. Our standard Enrolment Form is available online from our school website <a href="www.tetotara.school.nz">www.tetotara.school.nz</a> or by visiting the School Office. Please return completed out-of-zone Enrolment Forms and relevant documentation to the School Office by <a href="Friday 23rd March">Friday 23rd March</a>, 2018.

The Board will look at the number of enrolments, the level of projected student growth and determine how many spaces for out-of-zone students are available for the upcoming enrolment period of **1st July 2018 - 14th December 2018**. This will be completed in late May, allowing for lots of time for families to know what is happening. Further information around the number of out-of-zone spaces to be released will be communicated via the school newsletter over the next few weeks.

#### DRIVER BEHAVIOUR AROUND OUR COMMUNITY

In a previous newsletter I had mentioned the concerns around driver behaviour around our community. The Police have been active in the area and last Thursday morning in a half hour period issued eight infringement notices around vehicles turning from Borman Road into Moonlight Drive. This is very close to the school and is a concern as our children use this intersection. There were a range of offences including running red lights, using cellphones and not wearing seatbelts. The Police have reported that there were a lot of Drivers (including those going to school) that were unable to be stopped as they did not have enough staff. It is highly likely that the Police will continue to monitor this area.

#### TEACHER PAID UNION MEETINGS - SCHOOL REMAINS OPEN

Under law, Teachers are able to meet to discuss Union matters twice a year for two hours. The New Zealand Education Institute(NZEI) has called their first meeting for Teachers in the Hamilton area on either Thursday 22nd or Tuesday 27th March.

Our Teachers have been very helpful in rostering themselves on different meeting times so that there are at least two teachers in each team at school during the meeting times, ensuring that there is adequate supervision on these days for the children. On these days you will notice different programmes in place to help cater for the children.

#### LOCK DOWN TRIAL - MONDAY 19TH MARCH, 2018 @ 11.15am

We have an obligation to trial this system in order for the school to be as prepared as possible for any such emergency. Our staff are trained to look after our children, reassure them and ensure both their physical and emotional safety. We have noticed that the more often we have these trials, the more familiar we all are with the systems. We will talk to our students about the trial beforehand.

#### HOW WE CONTACT YOU IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY AT SCHOOL

We will use social messaging, including Facebook, the School App and website. Also, we will phone if necessary, so it's a good idea to make sure you keep your contact details up-to-date with the School Office. It is important that you follow any directions given, especially around rushing to school if you hear of an emergency. This can cause congestion, confusion and stress. Please note that in a real incident that NZ Police will take control of access to/from the school, while we look after our children.


#### **SCHOOL ASSEMBLY**
