With our Year 0-2 year students we are developing and sharing their skills through a fun activity based event called the **"Have a Go" Day**. They will be rotated around the following activities:

High jump, long jump, sprints, quoits, long jump, egg and spoon, high jump, hurdles, cricket ball throw, parachute game.

- Children may arrive at school in <u>their house colours</u>; they can remain in their house colour clothes for the whole day.
- Check with your classroom teacher if you are unsure which house your child belongs in.
- Sports shoes are optional; children may wish to compete in bare feet.
- Te Totara bucket sun hats are compulsory.
- Plenty of lunch and water are important.
