"HAVE A GO" ATHLETICS DAY FOR YEARS 0-2 ONLY TUESDAY 3RD NOVEMBER, 2020

The Matawhero, Satellite Unit & Neptune 26 & 28 Teams will start at 9.10am, finishing at 11.50am. Orion & Neptune 24, 25, 27, Teams will start at 12.00 lunchtime, finishing at 2.15pm. With our Year 0-2 students, we are developing and sharing their skills through a fun activity based event called the 'Have a Go' Day. They will be rotated around the following activities: High jump, long jump, sprints, quoits, egg and spoon, hurdles, cricket ball throw and parachute games.

- Children may arrive at school in their house colours; they can remain in their house colour clothes for the whole day

- Sports shoes are optional; children may wish to compete in bare feet
- Te Totara bucket sun hats are compulsory
- Plenty of lunch and water are important
