DROP-OFF ZONE IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL

New Line Markings and Arrows

During the school holidays we have refreshed our line markings in the 'drop off zone' in front of the Administration block. We have also added in some arrows that clarify which lane you are to enter if you are going **left** or **right** after picking up your children. Both lanes are able to turn right to travel back down Hector Drive towards Borman Road, however **only the inside lane** closest to the Administration block **is available for a left turn** up Hector Drive towards Rototuna High School.

There is no 'lane changing' once you are inside the drop off lane so please ensure you enter in the correct lanes. This is to ensure vehicle safety inside our school area.

SEAT BELTS IN VEHICLES

We have been observing a few students who have not been safely sitting in their car seats with the seat belt fasten securely, before the car moves off. This is an illegal and highly dangerous practise, if the car has to stop suddenly the risk for injury of unsecured children is very high. It is also not modelling good vehicle safety practises to your children. We are very conscious of the risk in this and will be stopping vehicles that move off without children being secure.

Mrs Fraser is being very active in this regard in the drop off zone area that she manages. Please train your child to:

- get into the car quickly,
- take their bag off their back and stow it safely
- and immediately secure their seat belt around them.

This way they are safe and ready to go without holding up the flow of traffic.


A number of students are appearing with different coloured jackets/sweatshirts.
