TEACHER PAID UNION MEETINGS - SCHOOL REMAINS OPEN

Under law, teachers can meet to discuss Union matters twice a year

for up to two hours. The New Zealand Education Institute (NZEI) has called their first meetings for Teachers in the Hamilton area on a couple of dates in June; Wednesday 23rd June, 2020, two different times slots (West Hamilton) and Tuesday 29th June 2021 two different times slots (East Hamilton). These meetings are just over an hour long so the staff will be back on site for the next time block of the school day.

Our Teachers have in past years been very helpful in rostering themselves on different meeting times so that there are at least two teachers in each team at school during the meeting times, ensuring that there is adequate supervision on these days for the children. On these days we will run different learning programmes at these times to help cater for the children. We will be well prepared for this day.

Children 3 years old and under are FREE, <u>provided they are sitting on the knee of a paying</u> <u>adult ticket.</u> Otherwise, you <u>must</u> purchase a separate ticket for them.

Limited to 300 tickets each performance. Sorry, <u>NO</u> door sales on the night.

- Payment of tickets is through KINDO. Sorry, we will not be accepting any payments through internet banking or through the School Office.
- If you do not have access to a computer, you are welcome to use the school iPad which is available in the School Office. If you do not have an email address, please contact Marise Crow 07 853-0039 ext. 858.
- Tickets are non-refundable nor transferable so please ensure you are ordering the correct day/time.
- We acknowledge that some families may have children performing on both days and may have to purchase tickets for each of the days. Unfortunately, we cannot offer any solution to this as the money from ticket sales goes towards the costumes, lighting, sound, backdrops etc.
- Only 300 tickets are available for each performance so don't miss out!. NO extra seating or standing room will be allowed due to Health & Safety Regulations.
- The School Office will regularly check sales through KINDO and will send colour coded ticket/s home with the oldest child in each family within a few days of purchase: *Tuesday 22nd June ticket colours:* 2.00pm/Purple ticket and 6.00pm/Yellow ticket Wednesday 23rd June ticket colours: 2.00pm/Orange ticket and 6.00pm/Blue ticket
- Please remember to bring your ticket to the performance; this will confirm you have purchased a seat. <u>Sorry. no ticket - no entry</u> – there will be <u>NO DOOR SALES</u>. There will be <u>no</u> general reserved seating available for parents/families.
- Doors open for Matinee Performances at 1.30pm / Evening Performances doors open at 5.30pm
- The number on your ticket is NOT your seat number, seating is on a first-come-first-served basis.
- There will be an area allocated for wheelchair access and seating. If you require this service, please make sure you indicate this when purchasing your tickets through KINDO.
- <u>All Year 1 & 2 students</u> are required to attend each of their own team performances. Students performing on the day/evening do not require a ticket.
- For evening performances the Lead Characters (Stella, Stephen, Sophie & the Narrators) are required to meet in the Staffroom at 5.30pm.
- All other evening performance students are to arrive at **5.30pm** and go directly to their allocated classrooms to meet their teacher where they will be supervised.
- All our students will have an opportunity to watch a dress rehearsal of the Junior School Production during school time so please <u>do not</u> buy your child who attends Te Totara a matinee performance ticket.


