### **OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR 2023**

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on our school website by clicking the following link: <u>www.tetotara.school.nz</u>

There will be two 2023 out-of-zone enrolment periods:

The First enrolment period runs from 16th December 2022 – 30th June 2023

The Second enrolment period runs from 1st July 2023 – 15th December 2023

The Board has determined the following places are likely to be available to out-of-zone students from 2023 onwards. Enrolment period of **16th December**, **2022 - 30th June**, **2023**:

25 places for New Entrants (whose 5th Birthday falls within the above enrolment period)
5 places for Year 1 students
1 place for a Year 2 student
15 places for Year 3 students
10 places for Year 4 students

The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

For students seeking enrolment within the above enrolment period, the deadline for receipt of out-of-zone applications is **3.00pm Friday 23rd September**, **2022** and should be emailed to: receptionist@tetotara.school.nz

Parents of students who live within the home zone should also apply by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately for this year. Students who live in the home zone are entitled to enrol at the school.

Applications from out-of-zone students will be processed in the following order of priority:

a) **First priority** must be given to students who have been accepted for enrolment in a special programmes) run by the school and approved by the Secretary of Education\*.

- \* This priority is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Ministry of Education
- b) Second priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school.
- c) Third priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a former student of the school.
- d) Fourth priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.
- e) Fifth priority must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the Board of the school, or a child of a member of the Board of the school.
- f) Sixth priority must be given to all other applicants.

If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot supervised by a Justice of the Peace, a Practicing Lawyer or a Police Officer in accordance under Section 11G (1) of the Education Act 1989.

If a ballot for out-of-zone is required, it will be held on <u>Friday 14th October, 2022</u>. Parents will be informed of the outcome by Wednesday 19th October, 2022.
