"HAVE A GO" ATHLETICS DAY FOR YEARS 0-2 ONLY WEDNESDAY 9TH NOVEMBER, 2022

With our Year 0-2 students, we are developing and sharing their skills through a fun activity based event called the 'Have a Go' Day. They will be rotated around the following activities: Sprints, Parachute, Long Jump, Egg and Spoon, Cricket Ball Throw and High Jump.

The Matawhero Team and Neptune 28 and 27 will start at 9.10am, finishing at 11.50am. Orion Team, Satellite & Neptune 24 and 25 will start at 12.00 lunchtime, finishing at 2.30pm.

Have a Go Day Information:

- Children may arrive at school in their house colours; they can remain in their house colour clothes for the whole day
- Check with your classroom teacher if you are unsure which house your child is in
- Sports shoes are optional; children may wish to compete in bare feet
- Te Totara bucket sun hats are compulsory
- Plenty of lunch and water are important
- If the weather is not looking good we will postpone it to the following week (Wednesday 16th November).

TE TOTARA SCHOOL HOUSES

- Te Totara School has four houses, all named in line with our STARS theme and space expeditions:

- Children are placed in houses when they arrive at school. New Entrants with family members already at school will be placed in the same house.

BANISH THE BITES: FREE SEMINAR Monday 14th November, 2022 in the Matariki Hall @ 6.30pm

Did you know last year in New Zealand over 20,000 dog bite-related incidents were reported to ACC, 1500 were from the Waikato alone? More worryingly around one-third of those were attacks on children under 12 years old. Most people would assume that this would be due to children approaching strange dogs, but what's really disturbing is that over 70 percent of those attacks were from dogs that lived in the family household.
