INTRODUCING OUR NEW CONFIDENCE COURSE

At the end of last term the first two stages (trails) of our Confidence Course were completed. This is situated towards the boundary of our back field. A local company '*Playground Creations*' who have built other playgrounds for us came up with a 4-stage design that will stretch around the corner of the field towards the Galaxy covered court area. We were able to use school funding and a very generous donation of \$15,000 from the P.T.A. to complete Trail 1 and 2, including the proper grass retention matting underneath the climbing structures. We asked the designers to make a new design incorporating the history of our area and our Stars Matariki theme.



The first trail links us to our tuna (eels) and the Waikato River. It sees the children making their way through the Awa (river) by balancing - step from log to log and crawl through the rings that represent the tuna nets.

Trail 2 - Matariki represents the new year in the Maori lunar calendar - two stars at either end for social play - weaving through the tail balance logs without touching the ground providing core strength.

We are absolutely delighted with the Confidence Course which the students are really enjoying; as a curriculum activity and also in break times. We are very much hoping to complete Stages 3 and 4 at the end of this year by using school funding, applying for



community grants and P.T.A. donation following a Knowledgathon next term that our learners can be part of. It will be great to have the full fitness trail completed for our students by the start of next year.

We have managed to include a lot more of each child's comments and goals, to ensure they have an increased sense of ownership of their Learning Plan.

In our Junior Learning Plans we have added the Better Start Literacy Testing Data. Better Start Literacy is a new Reading Programme being taught in all Year 1-2 classrooms. The testing data will be added to these tables over the course of the year. On each box there is a proficiency level which means when the proficiency score has been reached this test will not be repeated.
