This online system allows you to pay school fees, order school lunches etc and is the ONLY way to register/pay for your child for sports teams and class trips.





SIBLING OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR 2024 Enrolment Period of 16th December, 2023 - 5th July, 2024


Our School Board is looking to accommodate, if possible, younger siblings of current students and children of staff for the 2024 school year. To help determine this, we urgently need to have OUTZ Enrolment Forms into the School Office to help with this process. Please complete an OUTZ Enrolment Form for each child, which is available online from our school website by clicking the following link: www.tetotara.school.nz or by visiting the School Office.

The Board will look at the number of enrolments, the level of projected student growth and determine how many spaces for out-of-zone students are available for the upcoming enrolment period of **16th December**, **2023 to 5th July**, **2024**. This will be completed in mid October, allowing for lots of time for families to know what is happening. Further information around the number of out-of-zone spaces to be released will be communicated via the school newsletter over the next few weeks.

SEAT BELTS IN VEHICLES

We have been observing a few students who have not been safely sitting in their car seats with the seat belt fastened securely, before the car moves off. This is an illegal and highly dangerous practice, if the car has to stop suddenly the risk for injury of unsecured children is very high. It is also not modelling good vehicle safety practices to your children. We are very conscious of the risk in this and will be stopping vehicles that move off without children being secure.





- Get into the car quickly,
- Take their bag off their back and stow it safely and immediately secure their seat belt around them.

This way they are safe and ready to go without holding up the flow of traffic.
