She is returning to nurture her love of working with young children by classroom teaching in a Year 2 class at Rai Valley Area School. She and Colin are looking forward to new adventures and a slightly slower pace of life in a stunning part of New Zealand's wine country. We thank her so much for being such a wonderful member of our Te Totara school family and we wish her all the best in her new endeavours.

Our Senior Leadership and School Board have worked through a rigorous process over the past month to select a new Assistant Principal for our school. We have chosen a very experienced teacher and leader for the position. Our new Assistant Principal from the beginning of Term 4 is **Mrs Maree Lewis.**

Maree has considerable experience in the role. She has a successful working knowledge of all aspects of Senior Leadership, having been an Assistant and Deputy Principal in recent years. She has worked at the Ministry of Education and also at the University of Waikato in the Graduate teacher programme. Miss Sweeney has previously taught at Te Totara School for many years and is an experienced teacher. She is very excited to be able to continue the great learning programmes set up by Mrs Lewis and to support Room 10 through this short term change.


