- 3. In person using EFTPOS at the school office.





ROUTINE HEARING CHECKS IN SCHOOL Term 4 Testing Date Fri 1 December 2023 @ 9.30am Information on Hearing Checks in School



Hearing Technicians from Community Health will be visiting our school. The objective of the test is to identify previously undetected hearing defects.

Which children are routinely checked?

- Children who have not completed hearing checks as part of their B4 School Check
- Children absent from previous visit, require retests or follow up In special circumstances, parents, teachers or others may request a hearing check

Please note...they only do requests for hearing. If there are concerns for vision in a student, the family will need to take their child to see an optometrist.

If any parents/caregivers <u>do not</u> want their child to be checked, or their child is currently under specialist care for a vision or hearing defect, they should let the school know.
