## MEET THE TEACHER EVENING WEDNESDAY 7TH FEBRUARY, 2024 (WEEK 2)




We are very keen to continue to have close links between home and school, so we have arranged for a Meet the Teacher session for families, a great way to stay really connected with the school.

#### HOT DAY PROTOCOL



When we have very hot weather we operate a Hot Day Protocol at school. Usually our children go outside during the breaks to play with friends and enjoy the benefits of being active. We recognise that with the very hot weather this can pose some risks, especially around dehydration and heat related concerns. So on very hot days we will be having an indoor option for the children to use at break times, typically anything over 25 degrees in the forecast will trigger the Hot Day Protocol. We are fortunate that all our inside areas (apart from the Matariki Hall) are air conditioned so it allows for optimum learning and teaching conditions.

#### SUN SAFETY

During the summer (Terms 1&4), all pupils are encouraged to put on sunscreen at home before school and **MUST** wear a named regulation school hat while outside.

Our Sun Sense Policy is: No hat – play in the shade

#### SWIMMING - TERM 1, 2024

Our Swimming Pool is all set for the season starting today, 1st February with the Year 2 students in Rooms 24 & 25. Our swimming instructor from Kelly Sports is really looking forward to seeing the children and helping them with their swimming skills. Looking at the statistics of swimming rescues this year has certainly shown the value of having our swimming programme up and running for our Tamariki.




## 2024 FEES & DONATIONS PAID VIA KINDO

## 2024 YEAR 5&6 SCHOOL CAMP

School Camp is payable **through KINDO ONLY**. If you are not registered for KINDO, please refer to our school website <u>www.tetotara.school.nz</u> and follow the instructions in the red quick link tab labelled "Fees & Donations" OR access KINDO through our School App.

Please <u>do not</u> pay for School Camp through internet banking OR send any money to the school.

**\$180.00 full payment <u>OR</u> pay in smaller installments through KINDO.** 2024 Camp fees are now loaded on KINDO.

There is also a **"Pay it Forward"** option to contribute towards the Camp Fees of other students whose families are experiencing financial hardship. You can contribute \$10.00, \$20.00 or even \$50.00 if you wish. This option will be available to our wider school community as well. Thank you for your kindness, it is very much appreciated!

#### MATHSEEDS (Yrs 1-2) & MATHLETICS (Yrs 3-6) TO HELP LEARNING

Teachers are encouraging their students with this interactive computer programme as it helps with important maths skills; you will also find teachers using it in their daily maths programmes.

We have been so impressed with how motivated the children have been producing excellent results. Shortly, we will be invoicing families \$20.00 per student to join Mathletics for 2024. Please pay this fee by <u>KINDO</u>. Fees will be loaded within the next few weeks.

#### **BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE**

We have an <u>optional</u> 'Bring Your Own Device' procedure at school for Year 3-6 students only. We have very clear protocols around this which need to be adhered to. The Team Leaders and Teachers will outline these to families in this area of the school as part of their Meet the Teacher presentations on Seesaw. #### **CHANGE OF DETAILS/ADDRESS**

#### **SCHOOL HOURS**

Just a reminder that school starts at **8.55am sharp** and it is important for children to be here at that time. We appreciate your efforts however; if for any reason you do arrive late (after 8.55am) please report to the School Office where a "Late Card" will be issued to your child before heading to your learning area. School finishes at 3.00pm.

#### EARLY ARRIVAL AT SCHOOL BEFORE 8.15AM

Children are welcome to arrive at school from 8.15am onwards. The school gates are closed until 8.15am each day. Teachers have planning to do before school in their classrooms and are unavailable to supervise any students arriving before 8.15am. We offer a Before School Care facility; Enrolment Forms are available from the School Office or via our School website www.tetotara.school.nz

#### LATE ARRIVALS (AFTER 8.55AM)

We ask parents to ensure their children arrive at school with at least five minutes to spare, for them to organise themselves by hanging up their school bag and sorting their book bag independently. We understand there may be rare occasions where your child arrives late at school (after 8.55am). We require families to report to the School Office for your child to be issued a Late Card prior to heading to their learning areas. We appreciate your effort in ensuring your child/ren arrive at school in good time before the first bell at 8.55am.



#### PROCEDURE WHEN STUDENTS ARE AWAY DUE TO FAMILY HOLIDAY ETC

From time to time families wish to take their children out of school for various events not related to illness. Simply notifying the teacher/school verbally is not sufficient. The correct procedure is to write or email Jo Stewart (Acting Principal) at jos@tetotara.school.nz and

#### **ALLERGIES/MEDICAL CONDITIONS**

In the event of a medical emergency, if your child has a medical condition, is taking regular medicine/tablets or has an allergy (including sticking plasters etc), please advise the School Office (*if you haven't already*), so we can amend your records accordingly.

We also have several children in school with allergies and we have procedures in place to keep these children safe, including not sharing food/drink, washing tables, and hand washing before and after eating. Thank you for your cooperation in these matters.

#### **APPOINTMENTS AT SCHOOL**

We love to see families at school and appreciate the home and school partnership. However, we are finding that we have a number of "cold callers" arriving and expecting to see either a leadership person or a teacher. This can pose problems as we often have commitments elsewhere and can't do justice to any queries that you may have. We certainly don't want to stop the great communication in place, but would appreciate either a phone call or email so that we can make an appointment to give you the time needed to sort out any queries. This phone call or email will need to be done a day or two prior to the appointment.
