

PRESCRIBED MEDICATION AT SCHOOL

From time-to-time it is necessary to administer medication to children at school. The Administration staff are happy to do this and follow the guidelines set out in the schools "Administration of Prescribed Medication by School Staff in Non-emergency Situations" Policy". The Policy also requires parents/caregivers to complete a "Medicine Notification/Consent Form". This form is found on our school website, or you can obtain a copy from the School Office, it is to be completed prior to any medication being administered.

ALL MEDICATION MUST BE HANDED IN TO THE SCHOOL OFFICE AND A MEDICINE CONSENT FORM COMPLETED. Medication provided to the school <u>must</u> have the name of the child, name of the drug and the dosage clearly stated on the box/bottle - preferably via your Family Doctor.



**** URGENT ** UPDATED IMMUNISATION RECORDS**

We recently sent emails to some families who have not yet provided us with an Immunisation Record for their child/ren which clearly states the date that each vaccination was given. In particular, the Measles or MMR (Measles, Mumps & Rubella) vaccine x2. Also, some families may have given us Immunisation Records for one child, but not for another.

If you wish to check if the school holds the correct up-to-date Immunisation Record for your child/ren, please phone the School Office on 07 853-0039, we are happy to check for you. You can also find this information on the Parent Portal for your child/ren.

However, we still have a large number of families who have not returned Immunisation Records for their child/ren. Your URGENT attention to this matter would be appreciated.

It is important that we hold the correct immunisation information for each student as we may be required to produce a report for the Health Department if there is an outbreak of an infectious disease at any stage.


Many thanks to those families who have already returned their full Immunisations Records for their child/ren, it is much appreciated.

OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR 2024

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on our school website <u>www.tetotara.school.nz</u>

The Board has determined the following places are likely to be available to OUTZ students from Term 3, 2024 onwards. Enrolment period: <u>6th July 2024 - 17th December 2024</u>:

10 places for Year 0 students (whose 5th Birthday falls within the above enrolment period)

The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

For students seeking enrolment within the above enrolment period, the deadline for receipt of OUTZ applications is **3.00pm on Friday 12th April**, **2024** and should be emailed to: *receptionist@tetotara.school.nz*

Parents of students who live within the home zone should also apply by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately for next year. Students who live in the home zone are entitled to enrol at the school.

Applications from OUTZ students will be processed in accordance with the Ministry of Education Order of Priority. Please visit our school website <u>www.tetotara.school.nz</u> under "Out-of-Zone Enrolments" for further information. Click the red link: <u>OUTZ Enrolment Form</u>

If the number of OUTZ applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot supervised by a Justice of the Peace, a Practicing Lawyer or a Police Officer in accordance with Section 11G (1) of the Education Act 1989.

If a ballot for OUTZ is required, it will be held on <u>Friday 26th April, 2024</u>. Parents will be informed of the outcome by **Wednesday 1st May, 2024**.
