It has been delightful to visit the classes during this week and see our settled hardworking learners and teachers.

We have been enjoying having a Maths consultant Bruce Moody working with Mrs Wine this week observing and offering feedback to our staff. We are involved in a two year contract with Bruce, which will allow us to reflect on and grow our strengths in Mathematics across the school.

PROGRESSIVE ACHIEVEMENT TESTING

During the next 2-3 weeks the students from Years 3,4,5,6 will be completing a series of important assessments that we do at this time every year called PAT Tests. (Progressive Achievement Tests).

They are in the curriculum areas of Literacy; Listening and Reading Comprehension and Reading Vocabulary, and Mathematics.

These assessments are standardised and provide useful information about the student's strengths and needs. Teachers use this information to track student progress and to plan their programmes.

The results of these assessments, once marked, are put onto the students Learning Plans which will be discussed with you at the Learning Plan interviews in Week 9 of this term.

SPORTS AT TE TOTARA

If your child may be interested in playing any of these sports now is an opportunity to discuss this with them.
