MEDICAL ATTENTION AT SCHOOL

With 788 students currently at our school, there are many children who require medical attention during the school day. Thanks to the caring families we have at our school however, any phone calls/text made to the parents of a sick or injured child **MUST** come from the School Office staff, rather than from another parent. If a parent has a concern about another child, please liaise with the office direct.

We have an Accidents, Incidents & Illness Procedure and First Aid Trained staff in place to deal with matters and if deemed necessary, WE will make contact with the family.

CHICKENPOX

We have begun the term with a number of students away with chickenpox. According to the Ministry of Health Infectious Diseases Guidelines:

- Early signs are a fever and spots with a blister on top of each spot.
- The child is infectious from up to 5 days before appearance of the rash until lesions have crusted (usually about 5 days).
- Time between exposure and sickness is 13-17 days.
- This disease is spread by coughing and sneezing and by direct contact with weeping blisters.
- Exclusion from school is approximately a week from the date of the appearance of the rash.

If you are unsure whether your child should return to school, please see to your family doctor.
