- 1) Type your comment as a separate word document and attach it to your e-mail. It must be less than 500 characters in total (including punctuation and spaces).
- 2) In the subject line of your e-mail type Parent Comment Attn: Deputy Principal
- 3) Send it to dp@tetotara.school.nz
- 4) If you do not have access to e-mail, you are welcome to complete a "Learning Plan Comment Form", which is available from the classroom teacher or at the School Office; it gives you an example of the types of comments which are suitable for this box.

The parent comment for the end of the year is your opportunity to comment on how you feel about your children's learning and experiences at school this year. I put the comment on whenever they are sent to me, but to be included in the print version of the Learning Plan, due out on 30 November, I would need to have the comment either e-mailed or on a Comment Form by Tuesday 20th November. The print run for 520 learning plans and the compilation process takes over a week now so, hence the cut off time for the printed version.

Please note: Learning Plans are currently offline until 30th November 2012, due to teachers working on them.
