# SAFETY TO/FROM SCHOOL AND AROUND DOGS

We have had a visit from a concerned member of our community who lives on Chesham Street, her property backs onto the walkway to our school. She has a large dog (Rottweiler) who roams her enclosed section and is concerned at the amount of teasing the dog is receiving from some of our students who use this walkway.

We encourage our families to speak to your children and warn them of the dangers of teasing or playing with unsupervised dogs. The owner has asked for children to ignore this dog and to continue walking, biking or scootering to school.

Any dog roaming without an owner has the potential to cause serious harm. If you have a camera or mobile phone handy, it would be helpful to **take a photo of the dog** in question.
