ORDERING OF SCHOOL LUNCHES

School lunches will be delivered to our school every day for children's lunches at 12.15pm if ordered by 8.30am daily.

How it works:

- Order online anywhere, anytime on any device. You will receive an email confirming your child's order once you have placed the order.
- Please make sure you use the correct school and classroom details for your child to have their order delivered to our school, otherwise they may not get a lunch order.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to our school sausage sizzle on Tuesday 30th June 2015, there will be NO SCHOOL LUNCHES ORDERS accepted online that day.

LOST PROPERTY ON DISPLAY

Any property left at the school at the end of term e.g. clothing, shoes, socks etc. will be on display outside the Earth block (weather permitting) on **Tuesday 30th June**, **Cross County Day**. If the weather is bad, it will be on display inside the Earth Pod.

Please check to see if any items belong to your family as all unclaimed items (other than school uniform) will be donated to charity.

We will endeavour to return named school uniform items of clothing to their rightful owner however; any un-named school uniform will be given to the School Office and sold, with the proceeds returned to the school. As you can imagine, with 750 students at our school now, it doesn't take long before the Lost Property is full.



OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR 2015

The Board invites applications from parents who wish to enrol their sons and/or daughters at Te Totara Primary School, who will begin school within the remainder of the 2015 school year.

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on our school website www.tetotara.school.nz

The Board has determined that twenty (20) places are likely to be available to out-of-zone students for **Year 1 students from July 2015 to 17**th **December, 2015**.

Applications from out-of-zone students will be processed in the following order of priority:

- a) First priority must be given to any applicant who is accepted for enrolment in a special programme run by the school and approved by the Secretary of Education.
 - * Hamilton North Special School Satellite Programme
- b) Second priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school

- c) Third priority must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school
- Fourth priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school
- e) Fifth priority must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the Board of the school, or a child of a member of the Board of the school
- f) Sixth priority must be given to all other applicants

If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot, supervised by a Justice of the Peace or a Police Officer in accordance under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989. If a ballot is required, it will be held on Tuesday 21st July, 2015.

The deadline for receipt of applications for out-of-zone places is **3.00pm**, **Monday 20th July. 2015** and should be addressed to:

Parents will be informed of the outcome by **Friday 24th July, 2015**.

To help with future planning, we also encourage parents of students who live within our school zone, and have a sibling or child they wish to enrol at our school, please submit an Enrolment Form for them by the above date. Students who live within our school enrolment zone are entitled to enrol at the school.

OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR THE 2016 SCHOOL YEAR

Around August this year, our Board of Trustees will look at the number of enrolments, the level of predicted student growth and determine how many spaces (if any) for the 2016 School Year. This will be completed in September/October, allowing for lots of time for families to know what is happening.

To help determine this, we need to have Enrolment Forms in to the School Office to help with this process. Enrolment Forms are available online from our school website www.tetotara.school.nz or by visiting the School Office.


