SCOOTERING NEAR THE SCHOOL

Scootering is a really neat way to get to and from school. We have had a few instances of near misses on footpaths lately, so now might be a good time to go over road rules for scootering - especially around veering to the left on the footpath and taking care crossing roads.

SWIMMING UPDATE

Our school pool has been in operation for a year, we have recently reviewed the programme to see how it is all going.

We found our children have made significant gains according to NZ Swim Safe, which is the aim of our programme so we are very pleased with the results. We also found our running costs are high and we need to ensure we make the programme sustainable into the future.

Some major points:

- We are finishing the programme for this year now.
- We are moving the programme into a school year cycle from February to mid-May and September to December, allowing us to miss the winter cold.
- We have struggled with heating in winter and this causes lots of disruptions and costs.
- All of our classes will be able to get involved with the new timetable.
- Our youngest children will swim at the end of the year so those Year 1 children who enrol during the year get the opportunity to swim.
- We will move our billing system so that as a class completes their swimming they will receive their accounts around this time.
