UNWELL CHILDREN WHO NEED TO GO HOME

Our Administration Team and teaching staff act in the very best interests of your child and their well-being is paramount. When children arrive at the School Office, and depending on the situation, most of the children are offered a rest in our Wellness Room and re-assessed before a phone call home; often they return to their classroom.

We understand many of our families have work commitments however, if you are phoned by the school to collect your child from school due to illness, it would be appreciated if you could arrange for their collection as soon as possible. If your child is sick please keep them at home until they are well. If your child has diarrhoea or vomiting we ask that they do not return to school

unless they are well and have had no further diarrhoea or vomiting for 24 hours prior to returning – these bugs can be highly contagious.
