OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR 2016

The Board invites applications from parents who wish to enrol their sons and/or daughters at Te Totara Primary School for next year. It is likely there will be two out-of-zone enrolment periods for 2016.

The First enrolment period will be from **1st** January 2016 – 30th June 2016

The Second enrolment period will be from 1st July 2016 – 16th December 2016

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on our school website <u>www.tetotara.school.nz</u>

The Board has determined that fifty (50) places are likely to be available to out-of-zone students for the first enrolment period of 1st January 2016 – 30th June 2016 for the following 2016 year levels:

30 places for Year 1 students 5 places for Year 2 students 5 places for Year 3 students 5 places for Year 4 students 5 places for Year 5 students

The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

Applications from out-of-zone students will be processed in the following order of priority:

a) First priority must be given to any applicant who is accepted for enrolment in a special programme run by the school and approved by the Secretary of Education.

* Hamilton North Special School Satellite Programme

- b) Second priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school
- c) Third priority must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school
- d) Fourth priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school
- e) Fifth priority must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the Board of the school, or a child of a member of the Board of the school
- f) Sixth priority must be given to all other applicants

Parents of students who live within the home zone should also apply by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately for next year. Students who live in the home zone are entitled to enrol at the school. If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot, supervised by a Justice of the Peace or a Police Officer in accordance under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989.

The deadline for receipt of applications for out-of-zone places is **3.00pm on Monday 12th October 2015** and should be addressed to:

If a ballot is required, it will be held on <u>Thursday</u> <u>15th October 2015</u>. Parents will be informed of the outcome by **Tuesday 20th October**, 2015.

If you ask me now is the perfect time to revisit our slip, slop, slap message.



From September through to end of April, between 10am to 4pm when the sun's ultraviolet (UV) rays are most intense, your SunSmart School will be working very hard to ensure that children under their care are protected from dangerous UV rays. You can support your child/children's school by:

Providing your child/children with a SunSmart hat that will offer protection to the neck, ears and face to slap on at school when outside between 10am and 4pm. Cancer Society recommends broad brimmed or bucket style hats. Baseball caps/peak style caps are not SunSmart - they have been scientifically proven to not provide adequate sun protection. You can wear a SunSmart hat yourself as children like to copy you.

Slipping your child/children in cool protective clothing if your school doesn't have a school uniform - protective clothing covers as much skin as possible e.g. tops that covers the shoulders, arms and chest, collared shirts and longer style shorts.

With your permission your child will be encouraged to slop on SPF30+ broad spectrum sunscreen on any skin not covered by clothes. Should you wish, you may opt to



supply a labelled bottle with your child/children's name(s) which can be kept at the school. Remember nearly

80% of lifetime sun

exposure happens before the age of 18, so it's important to make sun protection a life-long

habit, starting as young as possible.
