#### SCHOOL NETWORK UPGRADE PROJECT

Next week we will be undergoing a major upgrade of our computer systems. This will see faster speeds for our wireless systems and add additional capacity around the campus. This work is 80% funded by the Government.

Work on this project will be from 3.30pm-1.00am for around two weeks. All our systems will continue to run as normal during the upgrade. Vehicles will depart from the gates near the Administration area to minimise any disruptions to our neighbours.

#### **CHICKENPOX**

We have a number of students away with chickenpox at present. According to the Ministry of Health Infectious Diseases Guidelines:

- Early signs are a fever and spots with a blister on top of each spot.
- The child is infectious from up to 5 days before appearance of the rash until lesions have crusted (usually about 5 days).
- Time between exposure and sickness is 13-17 days.
- This disease is spread by coughing and sneezing and by direct contact with weeping blisters.
- Exclusion from school is approximately a week from the date of the appearance of the rash.

If you are unsure whether your child should return to school, please see to your family doctor.

A copy of the Infections Diseases Guidelines can be found on the school website under "Infectious Diseases".
