MEASLES UPDATE FROM POPULATION HEALTH – 17 MAY, 2016

To Principals, Head Teachers and Boards of Trustees

We continue to receive notifications of new measles cases in the Waikato Region. In addition, we have a case of measles in both Fairfield College and Morrinsville College. Both schools have received letters advising home isolation for all non-immune students



Both schools have received letters advising home isolation for all non-immune students and staff. Home isolation includes staying away from school, sporting activities and all other social gatherings for two weeks.

Non-immune students and staff have been advised to remain in isolation from Morrinsville College until the 24th of May, and from Fairfield College until the 23rd May.

All students and staff who are immune (have documentation of 2 MMR vaccines, or born before 1969) do not need to go into isolation at all and can remain at school.

Isolation precautions are necessary only for non-immune students of these two Colleges to prevent the spread of measles. No other schools are affected by these isolation precautions at this stage. This means that sporting and interschool activities can continue, even with Morrinsville and Fairfield Colleges, as all at risk students from these two schools are at home in isolation.

If a case of measles is found to be in your school, the same process of home isolation for nonimmune students and staff will be put into place at that time. Population Health and your school will provide further information should that occur.

What should you do today?

- Ensure your child is up to date with their immunisations.
- Locate you/your child's immunisation records, either in a Well Child book, or from the GP.
- This documentation would be required if there was a case of measles in your school in the future.

If you or your child develops symptoms of measles:

• Phone your GP or call Healthline on 0800 611 116 for advice or seek medical attention depending on severity of illness. It is important to call first because measles is highly infectious, and people with measles can infect others in the waiting room.


• Stay at home and away from public places (such as sports events, gatherings, parties, school, work, child care, shopping centres, public transport and so on).

It is recommended that to help schools/pre-schools in the case of Measles case(s), all parents, if not already actioned; provide documented information regarding 2 doses of MMR to the school/preschool over the next week.

- When seeking documentation from your General Practitioner regarding your child's 2 documented doses of MMR, could you please ask them to state clearly that 2 documented doses of MMR have been given, and not just immunised for age.
- For overseas students or where vaccination documentation is from overseas then if possible please get your General Practice to sight these to clarify that you have received 2 documented doses of MMR or measles vaccine. Also, please ask for them to also state clearly where appropriate that 2 doses of MMR or measles vaccine have been given. Thanks, this will help the school who are sighting the relevant vaccination documentation.



PLEASE NOTE: Many of our families have provided an Immunisation Certificate signed by the GP stating that your child has been fully immunised for age e.g. 5 years (left page).

However, the Waikato DHB requires you to provide the actual Immunisation Record (right page) which clearly states the dates both doses of MMR have been given.

If you are unable to locate the Immunisation Record, found at the back of the Plunket Book, please ask your GP to provide you with a print-out an Immunisation Status report (see below) that clearly states both doses of MMR have been given.

WHAT IS MEASLES?

- Measles is a highly infectious viral disease that can be serious.
- It is spread from person to person through the air by breathing, sneezing or coughing. Just being in the same room as someone with measles can lead to infection if you are not immune.
- The first symptoms of measles are a fever, and one or more of a runny nose, cough and sore red eyes. After a few days a red blotchy rash comes on and lasts up to one week. The rash usually starts on the face and spreads to the rest of the body. Measles can be very serious.

Students and teachers with measles are infectious from 5 days before to 5 days after the onset of rash and must stay away from school and follow the advice of the local Medical Officer of Health.

UPDATED IMMUNISATION RECORDS

An e-mail has been sent to families who have not provided the school with an Immunisation Record for their child/ren clearly indicating that 2x MMR vaccines have been given and dated. Some families may have given us Immunisation Records for one child, but not for another.


If you wish to check the school holds correct up-to-date Immunisation Record for your child/ren, please phone the School Office on 07 853-0039, we are happy to check for you.

However, we still have a large number of families who have not returned Immunisation Records for their child/ren. <u>Your URGENT attention to this matter</u> would be appreciated.

It is important that we hold the correct immunisation information for each student as we may be required to produce a report for the Health Department if there is an outbreak of an infectious disease at any stage. Many thanks to those families who have already returned their full Immunisations Records for their child/ren.

SCHOOL SORES (IMPETIGO)

We have several cases of School Sores reported at our school recently. This is a reminder to keep an eye out for blisters on exposed parts of the body, such as hands, legs and face. The blisters burst and turn into a sore with a yellow crust that gets bigger each day. The sores are itchy and spread easily to other parts of the skin. Impetigo is easily spread to other children and



adults by direct contact with the discharge from infected skin. They are **highly contagious** and children are infectious until sores are healed. To avoid the risk of infection, please ensure all open sores are kept well covered. If you have any concerns, please visit your Doctor as antibiotics are required to treat Impetigo. OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR THE PERIOD OF 1ST JULY, 2016 TO 16TH DECEMBER, 2016

The Board invites applications from parents who wish to enrol their New Entrant sons and/or daughters at Te Totara Primary School, who turn 5 years of age between the dates of 1st July 2016 – 16th December 2016.

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on our school website www.tetotara.school.nz

The Board has determined that twenty (20) places are likely to be available to out-of-zone students for the first enrolment period of **1st July 2016 – 16th December 2016.** The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

Applications from out-of-zone students will be processed in the following order of priority:

- a) First priority must be given to any applicant who is accepted for enrolment in a special programme run by the school and approved by the Secretary of Education.
 - * Hamilton North Special School Satellite Programme
- b) Second priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school
- c) Third priority must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school
- d) Fourth priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school
- e) Fifth priority must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the Board of the school, or a child of a member of the Board of the school
- f) Sixth priority must be given to all other applicants

Parents of students who live within the home zone should also apply by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately for next year. Students who live in the home zone are entitled to enrol at the school.

If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot, supervised by a Justice of the Peace or a Police Officer in accordance under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989.

The deadline for receipt of applications for out-of-zone places is **<u>3.00pm on Friday 27th May 2016</u>** and should be addressed to: Te Totara Primary School, PO Box 28134, Hamilton 3256

If a ballot is required, it will be held on <u>Wednesday 1st June 2016</u>. Parents will be informed of the outcome by Tuesday 7th June, 2016 (3 working days later - Monday 6th June is Queens Birthday Holiday).
