LEARNING PLANS HOME TOMORROW

A Learning Plan for each student will be sent home on **Friday 8th July, 2016** with the oldest or only child from each family. However, if your child started in Term 2 (from Monday 2nd May onwards) they will not receive a Learning Plan yet, they will receive one in Term 4 this year. For our New Entrant students beginning in Term 2, your child's teacher will be talking to you about your child's progress after we have completed the 5-year Entry testing. The Learning Plans will also be available online after **3.00pm on Friday 8th July, 2016**.
