
ICE BLOCK FRIDAY TOMORROW – Friday 21st October, 2016



- Take the quiz to be sure http://www.nzblood.co.nz/give-blood/donating/am-i-eligible/
- You cannot donate blood if you: Spent more than a total of 6 months in the United Kingdom, France or the Republic of Ireland between 1980 and 1996 or received a blood transfusion in ANY of these countries since 1980.
