STAFF UPDATE

Over the last month we have been preparing for next year by advertising and making teaching appointments, This has seen a very positive response and we are delighted with the appointments made. We are aiming to finalise all of our staffing before the end of the school year when we will be able to update everyone.

Meanwhile, we congratulate Jemma Campbell, our Teacher in Room 31, who has gained a position at Maeroa Intermediate teaching Dance & Drama. Jemma will be leaving sometime in Term 4 and we will continue to liaise with parents of Room 31 around future teaching arrangements.

MEDICAL ATTENTION AT SCHOOL

With 802 students currently at our school, there are many children who require medical attention during the school day. Thanks to the caring families we have at our school however, any phone calls/text made to the parents of a sick or injured child **MUST** come from the School Office staff, rather than from another parent or the student. If a parent has a concern about another child, please liaise with the office direct.

We have an Accidents, Incidents & Illness Procedure and First Aid Trained staff in place to deal with matters and if deemed necessary, **We** will make contact with the family.

FAMILY HOLIDAYS TAKEN DURING TERM TIME

We have noticed that a trend of parent condoned holidays taken during the school term. Please consider the effect this has on your child's learning by taking holidays at this time.

The school is more than comfortable for students not to be at school due to illness and health issues, and families are really good at liaising with us about this.

We do monitor trends and patterns on a weekly basis and will often liaise with families where there is a concern.

The Ministry of Education has asked for an attendance rate of **94%** and we are trying to lift attendance to this level at least. We are currently sitting at an attendance rate of **92.75%** If you have any queries around this, please don't hesitate to contact me.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

We are delighted with the large number of students who look really great by wearing their uniform in the correct manner. However, several students who are not complying with our Uniform Expectations and we ask your assistance with this.

All students are expected to be wearing their full correct uniform.

Students are to arrive at school and leave from school in their Te Totara Primary School uniform, including footwear.

Please note: In Term 4, 2017 our Te Totara Red Bucket hat is compulsory for our children to wear.

CHILDREN NOT COLLECTED AFTER SCHOOL

Lately, we have noticed an increase in children being picked up late from school. Remember, After School Care facilities are available at our school for \$6.00 - \$8.00 per hour per child. Enrolment forms can be obtained from the School Office. **School Finishes at 3.00pm.**

OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR 2018

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on our school website www.tetotara.school.nz

The Board has determined that <u>11 places for New Entrant (Year 1) students</u> are likely to be available to out-of-zone students for the enrolment period of <u>16th December 2017 – 30th June 2018</u>

The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

In 2018 there will be two out-of-zone enrolment periods:

The First enrolment period runs from 16th December 2017 – 30th June 2018

The Second enrolment period runs from 1st July 2018 – 14th December 2018

For students seeking enrolment within the first enrolment period of 16th December 2017 - 30th June 2018, the deadline for receipt of out-of-zone applications is 3.00pm on Friday 29th September, 2017 and should be addressed to: Te Totara Primary School, PO Box 28134, Hamilton 3256

Please view previous school newsletters for the order of priority for out-of-zone applications.

If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot supervised by a Justice of the Peace, a Practicing Lawyer or a Police Officer in accordance under Section 11G (1) of the Education Act 1989.

If a ballot for out-of-zone is required, it will be held on <u>Friday 13th October</u>, <u>2017</u>. Parents will be informed of the outcome by **Wednesday 18th October**, <u>2017</u>.

- * With no physical or intellectual disabilities


And display at least 2 of the next symptoms:
