OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR 2018

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on our school website www.tetotara.school.nz

The Board has determined that <u>11 places for New Entrant (Year 1) students</u> are likely to be available to out-of-zone students for the enrolment period of 16th December 2017 – 30th June 2018.

The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

In 2018 there will be two out-of-zone enrolment periods:

The First enrolment period runs from 16th December 2017 – 30th June 2018

The Second enrolment period runs from 1st July 2018 – 14th December 2018

For students seeking enrolment within the first enrolment period of 16th December 2017 - 30th June 2018, the deadline for receipt of out-of-zone applications is 3.00pm on Friday 29th September, 2017 and should be addressed to: Te Totara Primary School, PO Box 28134, Hamilton 3256

Please view previous school newsletters for the order of priority for out-of-zone applications.

If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot supervised by a Justice of the Peace, a Practicing Lawyer or a Police Officer in accordance under Section 11G (1) of the Education Act 1989.

If a ballot for out-of-zone is required, it will be held on <u>Friday</u> <u>13th</u> <u>October</u>, <u>2017</u>. Parents will be informed of the outcome by **Wednesday 18th October**, <u>2017</u>.

KIDS FOR KIDS CHOIR (Selected Pupils Only)

The children will need to be at school on the Wednesday morning by 8.50am. They will need to wear the correct Te Totara Primary school uniform (clean and tidy) and bring with them a small snack and drink for morning tea.

The evening concert date is also Wednesday 25^{th} October. In the evening of the concert the children will need to be backstage by <u>6.45pm</u>. The concert starts at 7.30pm and is due to finish at 9:30pm (this includes a 20 minute interval).

For the evening performance the children are asked to wear bright coloured clothing. No jackets or jerseys are to be worn on stage as it can become very warm performing under lights.

SCHOOL SWIMMING TIMETABLE FOR TERM 4 2017


