Most New Zealanders will have some experience of cancer, either personally or through a relative or friend. One in three New Zealanders will be diagnosed with cancer in their lifetime.

On Daffodil Day at morning tea two of our Learning Support Teacher Aides, Kate and Monique, and a past Te Totara pupil, Lucy McMorran, will be cutting their hair to raise money for The Cancer Society. The funds raised will support the work the Waikato/Bay of Plenty Cancer Society do to provide free supportive care services

and health promotion programmes, fund research and undertake advocacy. The organisation receives no direct government funding so let's support them!

Their hair will be donated for wigs for people who have lost their own hair due to cancer treatment. It takes five ponytails to make one wig and each hair is individually threaded & knotted into it. We would love others to join in the fun & consider donating their hair also, (your hair donation needs to be approx 30cm long and natural - so no colour), however we are on the lookout for another hairdresser to help out on the day. **TICKETS:** We ask families to please be mindful that there are many Year 3, 4, 5 & 6 families wanting to attend an evening performance therefore, we have to limit ticket sales to a **maximum of 2 tickets per family for the 7.00pm performance**. There may be extra tickets available to purchase closer to the event, we will let you know. Thank you in advance. **PLEASE NOTE: There is no ticket limit for the 1.30pm Matinee performances.** 

## ALL TICKETS ARE \$10.00 EACH

Children 3 years old and under are FREE, provided they are sitting on the knee of a paying adult ticket.

#### Otherwise, you must purchase a separate ticket for them.

Limited to 300 tickets each performance. Sorry, NO door sales on the night.

- Payment of tickets is through KINDO. Sorry, we will not be accepting any payments through internet banking or through the School Office.
- If you do not have access to a computer, you are welcome to use the school iPad which is available in the School Office. If you do not have an email address, please contact Marise Crow 07 853-0039 ext. 858.
- Tickets are non-refundable nor transferable so please ensure you are ordering the correct day/time.
- We acknowledge that some families may have children performing on both days and may have to purchase tickets for each of the days. Unfortunately, we cannot offer any solution to this as the money from ticket sales goes towards the costumes, lighting, sound, backdrops etc.
- Only 300 tickets are available for each performance so don't miss out!. NO extra seating or standing room
  will be allowed due to Health & Safety Regulations.
- The School Office will regularly check sales through KINDO and will send colour coded ticket/s home with the oldest child in each family within a few days of purchase: Wednesday 26th September Milky Way & Earth Teams (1.30pm/Pink ticket and 7.00pm/Blue ticket) Thursday 27th September Marama & Ra Teams (1.30pm/Yellow ticket and 7.00pm/Orange ticket)
- Please remember to bring your ticket to the performance; this will confirm you have purchased a seat. <u>Sorry. no ticket/no entry</u> – there will be <u>NO DOOR SALES.</u>
- Doors open for Matinee Performances at 1.00pm / Evening Performances doors open at 6.30pm
- The number on your ticket is NOT your seat number, seating is on a first-come-first-served basis.
- There will be an area allocated for wheelchair access and seating. If you require this service, please make sure you indicate this when purchasing your tickets through KINDO.
- <u>All Year 3, 4, 5 & 6 students</u> are required to attend each of their own team performances. Students performing on the day/evening do not require a ticket.
- All our students will have an opportunity to see a dress rehearsal of the Senior School Production during school time.

#### SWIM SCHOOL AFTER SCHOOL SWIMMING LESSONS, TERM 4 – LIMITED SPACES! Mon 8TH - Fri 12TH OCTOBER 2018, SCHOOL HOLIDAY - 1 WEEK BLOCK COURSE OF LESSONS

New Zealand has one of the highest drowning rates in the developed world. Unfortunately, 2018 has seen many drownings in New Zealand already.

We are looking at running a **1 week block course of swimming lessons in the second week of the school holidays, 8 - 12 October 2018**, lessons are generally held in the mornings from 9am - 1pm and fees for this block course of lessons would be \$80.00 per child.

We are looking at running a 7 week block course of Swimming Lessons in Term 4, 2018.

- Lessons will be 25 minutes one day per week, usually held on a Tuesday or Thursday.
- These will be small class numbers of children which is a great way to boost your child's confidence in the water. Fees for this 7 week course are \$115.00 per child.
- Lessons will be held from 3.30pm 6.00pm in our school pool. Approximate start date would be week 2, Term 4.
