The cut-off date for "Free Delivery" of Individual & Class Photo orders to the school is midnight on <u>Sunday 14th October, 2018.</u> Photos will be delivered to the school early in Term 4.

CHILDREN NOT COLLECTED AFTER SCHOOL

Lately, we have noticed an increase in children being picked up late from school. Remember, After School Care facilities are available at our school for \$6.00 - \$8.00 per hour per child. Enrolment forms can be obtained from the School Office. **School Finishes at 3.00pm** and we expect that children are collected no later than 3.15pm.

OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR 2019

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on our school website <u>www.tetotara.school.nz</u>

The Board has determined that <u>15 places for New Entrant (Year 1) students</u> are likely to be available to out-of-zone students for the enrolment period of **15th December 2018 – 30th June 2019**. The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

There will be two 2019 out-of-zone enrolment periods:

The First enrolment period runs from 15th December 2018 – 30th June 2019

The Second enrolment period runs from 1st July 2019 – 19th December 2019

For students seeking enrolment within the first enrolment period of 15th December 2018 - 30th June

2019, the deadline for receipt of out-of-zone applications is **3.00pm tomorrow, Friday 28th**

<u>September, 2018</u> and should be addressed to: *Te Totara Primary School, PO Box 28134, Hamilton* 3256

Parents of students who live within the home zone should also apply by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately for next year. Students who live in the home zone are entitled to enrol at the school.

Please view previous school newsletters for the order of priority for out-of-zone applications.

If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot supervised by a Justice of the Peace, a Practicing Lawyer or a Police Officer in accordance under Section 11G (1) of the Education Act 1989.

If a ballot for out-of-zone is required, it will be held on **<u>Friday 12th October, 2018</u>**. Parents will be informed of the outcome by **Wednesday 17th October, 2018**.

YEAR 6 LEAVERS – DESTINATION SCHOOL

Te Totara Court Cover Project Given Green Light

Te Totara Primary School will be a hive of activity in term 4 of this year, with the commencement of the long-awaited Tennis Court cover project.

Principal Brian Sheedy is delighted to announce the go-ahead of the court cover which will offer full coverage of the tennis court area. It will enable extended use of the area in sunny and wet weather and provide a large ventilated area for a wide range of uses.

"We are excited to have a space in which the entire school community can gather at the



same time. The cover will ensure that we have a physical play space that the children may use irrespective of the weather. We are very proud to be able to provide an asset of this calibre to our school".

Funds for the over \$500 000 project have come from the Ministry of Education, Board of Trustees, the Te Totara PTA and a generous donation from Summerset Rototuna.

Sheedy says, "Thanks to the generous support of our school and wider community for supporting the PTA fundraising over the last two years, which has enabled this important project to proceed. Every dollar collected has made a difference, and we acknowledge the fantastic effort made by the PTA in donating \$80,000 to assist this plan to fruition".

"We are also very grateful to Summerset Rototuna for their very generous donation of \$20,000. As our new neighbours, we look forward to welcoming them into our Te Totara community."

The building work is due to commence before the end of 2018 with completion expected by the start of the 2019 School year.
