INTERSCHOOL <u>SWIMMING TRIALS</u> (FOR YEAR 4-6 STUDENTS ONLY) Tuesday 19th February 2019 to be held at the Fairfield High School Pool

We will be holding Swimming Trials on Tuesday 19th February for our <u>Year 4-6 students</u> who are interested in representing Te Totara Primary School at the Fairfield Cluster Swimming Competition to be held in March.

If your child belongs to a Swimming Club or has shown an interest in participating in the trial, please register through KINDO. A Letter of Interest with further details was handed out today to those students interested in trialling.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: Your child **must** be able to swim **25m** in freestyle or backstroke and/or breaststroke at a **competitive** level to be able to trial.

The reason we are holding our trials at Fairfield College and not in our own pool is due to the fact that students will be racing over 25m without any turns. The competitive nature of Cluster Swimming Sports requires us to take our most competitive athletes, so trial times are important.

These trials are to determine who will represent the school at the Fairfield Cluster Swimming Sports day on <u>Tuesday 19th March</u>, <u>2019</u> (Years 4-6 students only).

There is <u>no charge</u> for this as students will travel by private motor vehicle however; you must register your child for the trial through KINDO. Registrations close on Sunday 17th February at 6.00pm As part of the registration process you will be asked if you are able to provide transport to/from this event.



tragically passed away on 10th January 2019 at Raglan Beach, we would like to hold a "Muffi Day" with the proceeds


being donated to Raglan Surf Lifesaving - an invaluable charity supported by his parents Rosina & Colin and extended family.

Hamilton City Council Water Alert Level 2

Hamilton City Council moved to Water Alert Level 2 on Tuesday which means sprinklers and watering systems can only be used on alternate days (eg even street numbers on even days; odd street numbers on odd days) between 6-8am and 6-8pm. Hand-held hosing can still be done any time. As high temperatures continue this week, Hamilton City Council is urging residents to cut back on non-essential water use to avoid moving to further water restrictions.
