Please Note:

- If there is a change to a red polo shirt, there will be a period in excess of 12 months whereby either the white polo shirt or the red polo shirt can be worn.
- The red polo shirt option, if it is adopted, would be the same or similar to the current red sports polo shirt without the school name on the back.
- The Board will make the change if there is a simple majority of responses received for the red polo shirt option. It is important that the vote includes your Eldest Child's Last Name & First Name so that the vote is counted. ONE vote per family only.




