The Learning Plans will also be available online from 4.00pm on Friday 29th November, 2019. Included in the information pack being sent home will be instructions on how to log-on to the Parent Portal site.

The work involved in developing these Learning Plans is immense and reflect our goal of developing a personalised plan for each student.

Much thought and consideration has gone into these Learning Plans. We

have managed to include a lot more of each child's comments and goals, to ensure they have an increased sense of ownership of their Learning Plan.



We strongly advise that you:

- Go through the Learning Plan with your child
- Look especially at the "Where To Next" and "Goals set by Student, Parent and Teacher" sections and incorporate these into supporting learning at home.

A REMINDER.... Please keep your Login and Password details for the Parent Portal handy, these will be inside the Learning Plan folder.

We encourage families to log-in to the Parent Portal and check we have the correct details for your child/ren e.g. mobile numbers, home address and email address.

From Friday 13th December 2019 @ 4.00pm this is also where you will find your child's class for 2020. Further details will follow.

TE TOTARA WHITE OR RED POLO SHIRT SURVEY - 80.3% YES, CHANGE TO A RED POLO SHIRT

Following on from our decision in August 2019 to change our school white polo top to the red polo top, we have further information for you.

There will be a **2-year** change over period so that by the beginning of the 2022 school year, the white polo shirt will be totally phased out and no longer worn by our students.



What does this mean?

- For the remainder of 2019 the white polo shirt is part of our school uniform and the only polo shirt available to purchase.
- The new red polo shirt design has been finalised by our uniform supplier Direct Group.
- Direct Group have advised the new red polo shirt will be available for purchase from 17th February 2020, this shirt will be the same length as the current white shirts. Until the 17th February a shorter length red polo shirt will be available to purchase from 6th January 2020.
- Our current red Sports Polo Shirt with "Te Totara Primary School" lettering on the back will remain
 for sports teams only. Students are NOT to wear this in place of the white polo it is a separate
 uniform item. The new red polo uniform shirt will NOT have large lettering on the back.
- There will be no more white polo shirts sold from the beginning of 2020 however, for the next 2 years we will see a mixture of both white and red polo shirts in our school which is fine as colour-wise they all mix well.
- Our current suppliers (Direct Group) are running down their stock of white polo shirts and are currently out of stock of Sizes 6, 8 & 10. In the interim, they will be providing families with a plain white polo shirt with our logo on.

END OF YEAR CELEBRATION - TUESDAY 10TH DECEMBER AT 5.45PM

This is our annual event to celebrate another great year at Te Totara. Here is some information to help make it a special event:

- It is a school event, so children need to be in a <u>clean and tidy uniform</u> and will be together as a school and are under the control of school staff.
- Please leave your child with us; we will take care of them.
- Students will need to stay through the whole event.
- There will be very limited parking available at the school car park and none in the turning bay.
- It will be best to find a car park on a nearby street and walk.
- It is like a concert in a park so bring a picnic, a rug to sit on, something to eat and drink and enjoy a variety concert.
- We use the hill behind Ra and Earth as outdoor stages where children perform.
- Toilets are open in the Ra and Earth blocks.
- Pre-schoolers are welcome to use the playground away from the performers so they don't distract from the performance.
- Other children not involved in the school are asked to be respectful and if they want to play, then the court area is a good place. There are likely to be over 2500 people at the event so we strongly advise walking to the event.



- NO dogs are allowed on our school grounds.
- We will have a "Paparazzi" section at the front for parents of those performing to use to get a good photo.
- If the weather is not good, we will postpone to Wednesday 11th December 2019, same time.
- Notifications will be put on the school Facebook page, school app and the website.
- The event is weather dependent, so may be cancelled at the last moment, but we will do our best to let everyone know as early as possible.
- At the end of the event we will need to stagger people leaving due to Health & Safety, so please be prepared to wait a little time. Announcements will be made to help.
