DROP-OFF/PICK-UP ZONE ROAD RULES AND SPEED LIMIT

Just a reminder to all our families that the speed limit is **5kms per hour in our drop-off/pick-up zone**. We have had some near misses recently so it is really important that we stick to the 5km per hour speed limit. Most of our community do a wonderful job in looking after our students in this situation however, I am very aware that some do not adhere to our speed limits and protocols despite all that we do to educate our families.



Ultimately, it is the driver's responsibility to look both ways for children who may be crossing before driving off.... children can be very unpredictable at times.

We do have staff rostered on duty in the drop-off zone in the mornings however this is not until 8:30am as they have preparation work to do beforehand.

Please note, current road rules also apply upon entering our drop-off/pick-up zone regarding positioning yourselves in the correct lane for turning out onto Hector Drive. At this stage the left lane closest to our school buildings is still able to be used for right turning as well. When leaving the drop-off zone if you wish to turn left onto Hector Drive, please position yourself in the LEFT LANE only, closest to the school buildings. The RIGHT LANE should be for cars turning right out onto Hector Drive. We have seen a few near miss accidents with cars crossing over lanes without indicating and not considering other drivers.

The Board will look at the number of enrolments, the level of projected student growth and determine how many spaces for out-of-zone students are available for the upcoming enrolment period of 17th December 2020 - 30th June, 2021. This will be completed in late September, allowing for lots of time for families to know what is happening. Further information around the number of out-of-zone spaces to be released will be communicated via the school newsletter over the next few weeks.


A HEADS UP..... LEARNING PLAN INTERVIEWS

\$2.00 per Ice block (lemonade) or bag of Potato Chips (Ready Salted, Salt & Vinegar or Chicken), while stocks last.


