#### SENIOR SCHOOL PRODUCTION

Our Prime Minister Jacinda Ardern has signalled an easing of restrictions next week - including bigger gatherings in Auckland and Level 1 freedoms for the rest of the country - if cases continue to track down as they have been. The Level 1 move has been agreed to in principle but relies on cases tracking as they have been, which would signal diminishing risk of someone carrying Covid-19 from Auckland to a different part of the country.



In terms of the production of 'Tut Tut,' which we had postponed from Week 8 to Week 10 we are continuing to plan for the performances next week.

The performance is scheduled for 3 matinees and evening performances on Tuesday 22nd, Wednesday 23rd and Thursday 24th September. The lighting and sound will be set up on Sunday 20th September. We are looking forward to a fabulous event.

If we are unable to move into Level 1 next week as anticipated, then we will still be able to perform the matinees as they have numbers under 100 attending. We would also endeavor to do a show particularly for the families of the main cast members as those children have been outstanding in the preparation efforts. We have also been looking at the possibility of a recorded show being made available for our families to purchase instead.

These ideas are not our preferred option however, we may need to have this response if we are still at Level 2. We will all keep our 'fingers crossed' for good news soon on the Covid 19 Alert Levels. I will update you as soon as the announcements are made using our School App, Facebook page and Seesaw.


#### YEAR 6 LEAVERS - DESTINATION SCHOOL FOR 2021

#### SWIM SCHOOL AFTER SCHOOL SWIMMING LESSONS, TERM 4 – LIMITED SPACES!

We are looking at running a 7-week block course of Swimming Lessons in Term 4, 2020.

- Lessons will be 25 minutes one day per week, usually held on a Tuesday or Thursday.
- These will be small class numbers of children which is a great way to boost your child's confidence in the water.
- Lessons will be held from 3.30pm 6.00pm in our school pool.
- Approximate start date would be week 2, Term 4.
- Fees for this 7-week course are \$125.00 per child.

#### **OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS PERIOD FOR 2021**

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on our school website **www.tetotara.school.nz** 

The Board has determined that 9 places for New Entrant (Year 1) students, whose 5th Birthday falls within the enrolment period of 17th December 2020 – 30th June 2021, are likely to be available to out-of-zone students. The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

There will be two 2021 out-of-zone enrolment periods:

The First enrolment period runs from 17th December 2020 – 30th June 2021

The Second enrolment period runs from 1st July 2021 – 16th December 2021

For students seeking enrolment within the first enrolment period of 17th December 2020 - 30th June 2021, the deadline for receipt of out-of-zone applications is 3.00pm on Friday 25th September. 2020 and should be addressed to: Te Totara Primary School, PO Box 28134, Hamilton 3256

If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot supervised by a Justice of the Peace, a Practicing Lawyer or a Police Officer in accordance with Section 11G (1) of the Education Act 1989.

If a ballot for out-of-zone is required, it will be held on <u>Friday 9th October</u>, <u>2020</u>. Parents will be informed of the outcome by **Wednesday 14th October**, <u>2020</u>.

Every year we create a full-colour Yearbook, to capture forever the fun and learning at our school. We would love to include your local business in this year's publication.


Our parents tell us that the Yearbook is often left on their coffee table for a good part of the year with other family members and friends pouring over it.
