END OF YEAR CELEBRATION - TUESDAY 8TH DECEMBER AT 5.45PM

This is our annual event to celebrate another great year at Te Totara. Here is some information to help make it a special event:

- It is a school event, so children need to be in a <u>clean and tidy uniform</u> and will be together as a school and are under the control of school staff.
- Please leave your child with us; we will take care of them.
- Students will need to stay through the whole event.
- There will be very limited parking available at the school car park and none in the turning bay.
- It will be best to find a car park on a nearby street and walk.
- It is like a concert in a park so bring a picnic, a rug to sit on, something to eat and drink and enjoy a variety concert.
- We use the hill behind Ra & Earth as outdoor stages where children perform.
- Toilets are open in the Ra and Earth blocks.
- Pre-schoolers are welcome to use the playground away from the performers so they don't distract from the performance.
- Other children not involved in the school are asked to be respectful and if they want to play, then the court area is a good place. There are likely to be over 2500 people at the event so we strongly advise walking to the event.
- Please <u>NO umbrellas</u> as it blocks the view of people behind. Low set chairs only are advisable if needed.
- NO dogs are allowed on our school grounds.
- We will have a "Paparazzi" section at the front for parents of those performing to use to get a good photo.
- If the weather is not good, we will postpone it to Wednesday 9th December 2020, same time.
- Notifications will be put on the school Facebook page, school app and the website.
- The event is weather dependent, so may be cancelled at the last moment, but we will do our best to let everyone know as early as possible.
- At the end of the event which should conclude by 7.30pm, we will need to stagger people leaving due to Health & Safety, so please be prepared to wait a little time. Announcements will be made to help.

SCHOOL UNIFORM REMINDERS

Following on from our decision in August 2019 to change our school white polo top to the red polo top, we have some reminders for you.

There will be a **2 year** change over period so that by the beginning of the 2022 school year, the white polo shirt will be totally phased out and no longer worn by our students.

- We are delighted with the large number of students who look really great by wearing their uniform in the correct manner.
- **JEWELLERY**, Items of jewellery can be easily lost or damaged at school. They may also cause injury to the wearer or other students. For safety reasons these are not to be worn. The school accepts no responsibility in the case of loss, damage or injury.
- However, students may wear:
- a) One small earring stud per ear. NO hoops or sleepers.
- b) A watch.
- c) A necklace of religious or cultural significance to be worn underneath clothing.
- d) A Medical Identification Tag (Medic Alert) if required
- Our current red Sports Polo Shirt with "Te Totara Primary School" lettering on the back will remain
 for sports teams only. Students are NOT to wear this in place of the white polo it is a separate
 uniform item. The new red polo uniform shirt will NOT have large lettering on the back.

FREE MEASLES, MUMPS & RUBELLA VACCINE

These last two years have highlighted the need to ensure our whānau and communities are safe from infectious diseases. Measles is about 8 times more contagious than COVID-19, and last year's outbreak is a reminder of just how quickly it can spread among unimmunised people. While we can't vaccinate against COVID-19 yet, we can protect against other infectious diseases like measles by being immunised.

Teenagers and young adults aged 15-30 are at greater risk of catching and spreading measles, as they are less likely to have been immunised as children. Find out more about measles at ProtectAgainstMeasles.org.nz

Voluntary School Donation payments can be made at the beginning of the year or throughout the year; the funds will be used for resources for the children.


