Kia ora o te whanau,

Yesterday the Prime Minister announced changes to the COVID-19 Protection Framework which will take effect from **11.59pm this Friday 25 March**, and to vaccine mandates and My Vaccine Pass, which will take effect from **11.59pm Monday 4 April**.



This means that **New Zealand and <u>Te Totara School</u> remain in the Red Setting**. Our Government will review the framework colour level on Monday 4 April. From 11.59 pm Monday, 4 April, the vaccine mandate covering staff in the education sector will be removed.

#### So what does this mean for Te Totara School at this time?

- Isolation for COVID-19 positive people and their household contacts remains at seven days.
- Vaccine passes and scanning will not be required at school for visitors from this weekend.
- Medical-grade masks remain a requirement for staff working indoors with children and masks for our Years 3-6 students. For all New Zealanders, including school settings, masks will not be required outdoors. We will continue to encourage all to wear masks as long as Omicron is present.
- Parents will still be asked to <u>drop children at school gates until the end of this term</u>. We are mindful that a second wave is still possible and do want to limit the spread as much as possible through maintaining a cautious approach.
- Over the next two weeks we will be making decisions about how we will be moving forward with our school guidelines in Term 2. Those guidelines will be communicated to you in the <u>newsletter of 7 April 2022</u>.

#### As mentioned we will continue as we are at the moment up until the end of Term 1 because:

- The safety and well being of our students and staff remains our paramount concern.
- We still have active cases of COVID amongst our school and staff families and there are still high levels of anxiety across the wider community.
- Staffing the school day to day continues to be a challenge. We are very grateful to our Deputy Principal Jo Stewart for the way she has skilfully ensured that we have teachers for each class, allowing our learning to continue uninterrupted.
- We only have 3 weeks of school until term ends.
- We are likely to be well through the COVID peak in early to mid April.
- This is consistent practice with our neighbouring schools.
- We are very mindful that there has been significant pressure on our staff this term and teachers are continuing to provide in class teaching, Seesaw activities and support for absent colleagues
- School leadership and the Board of Trustees need to make well-considered decisions around the Health and Safety of our students, staff, families including our more vulnerable community members. These will be the subject of discussions at our Board meeting next week.

Your ongoing support, patience and understanding is highly valued.

## LEARNING PLAN DISCUSSIONS BY PHONE/ZOOM + GOAL-SETTING LETTER

From Week 8 (this week) to Week 10 our teachers will be making contact by phone/zoom with each family for the Learning Plan interviews. These first interviews of the school year are to give you an update on how your child's learning and wellbeing is progressing at school. It is also to set some shared goals for them to work on. These are very important as they help all of us to focus on specific actions to help your child.

Usually we close early on a couple of days to help with these Learning Plan interviews. Despite the teachers doing the interviews via Zoom or phone calls over a more spread out time period, we are going to do an early school closure next week on **Wednesday 30th March** and **Thursday 31st March,2022**. On those two days <u>school will close at 2.00pm</u>, we expect all students to have left the school premises by 2.15pm unless they are enrolled at After School Care. This early closure will assist the teachers with additional times for their contact with you and also with the collating of these goals ready to put onto the Learning Plans.

Our staff are working very hard at the moment to ensure the school is able to remain open during the Covid outbreak for learning for our families. The staff have shortened break times and additional duties with the split break times. I am very grateful to our wonderful staff for all their hard mahi to ensure our children are safe, settled and learning well in the classrooms. This early closure is a small gesture to assist them with their considerable workload over these next few weeks. The school very much appreciates all your support in the early pick up on those two days.

For those of you who use our After School Care service, Katrina and her great team will be opening early at 2.00pm on those days, to cater for the early school closure.

Thank you to you all for working so well in this partnership, towards your child's learning success.

The whole school will finish at 2.00pm on Wednesday 30th March & Thursday 31st March 2022. After School Care will begin at 2.00pm, for those children enrolled. #### **OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR 2022**

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on our school website www.tetotara.school.nz

The Board has determined the following places are likely to be available to out-of-zone students from 2022 onwards. Enrolment period: 1st July - 15th December, 2022:

20 places for Year 0 students (whose 5th Birthday falls within the above enrolment period)

- 5 places for Year 2 students
- 1 place for a Year 3 student
- 6 places for Year 5 students

The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone. For students seeking enrolment within the above enrolment period, the deadline for receipt of out-of-zone applications is 3.00pm on Monday 25th April, 2022 and should be emailed to: receptionist@tetotara.school.nz.

Parents of students who live within the home zone should also apply by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately for next year. Students who live in the home zone are entitled to enrol at the school. An OUTZ Application Form and the order of priority for OUTZ applications can be found on our school website www.tetotara.school.nz under "Enrolment".

If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot supervised by a Justice of the Peace, a Practicing Lawyer or a Police Officer in accordance with Section 11G (1) of the Education Act 1989. If a ballot for out-of-zone is required, it will be held on Monday 9th May, 2022. Parents will be informed of the outcome by Wednesday 11th May, 2022.
