# A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRESIDING MEMBER (CHAIRPERSON) What It's Like to be on the Te Totara Primary School Board...

I have been a board member for three years now and I wanted to share my experience. th board elections coming up, I'm sure you are curious about what it's like to be on a school board. Some of the information out there can seem a little overwhelming, so I wanted to share my perspective in the hopes of making it less daunting.



Te Totara has a very strong leadership team and because the school is run with such efficient, high standards, the role of the board members is one of support as we oversee the running of the school. We do have to make decisions and cast our votes during meetings, but this job is made easy by the amount of information and guidance we are given by the senior management team.

Time wise, board matters average about 3-5 hours a month. We have a monthly, evening meeting which runs for about 1.5-2 hours where we are kept up-to-date on everything that is happening within the school and making sure we're on track with finances and the school charter. Prior to the meeting, we need to read through the paperwork which is sent the week before. These reports are discussed at the meeting and reading them takes me about 1-1.5 hours.

Occasionally there are extra commitments like being present at community events, attending the odd extra meeting or being involved in some interesting and relevant professional development, but generally, it's a pretty easy gig.

## SIBLING OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR 2023 Enrolment Period of 16th December, 2022 - 30th June, 2023

The Board of Trustees are looking to accommodate, if possible, younger siblings and children of staff in the 2023 school year. To help determine this, we urgently need to have Out-of-zone Enrolment Forms into the School Office to help with this process. Please complete an OUTZ Enrolment Form for each child, which is available online from our school website by clicking the following link: <a href="www.tetotara.school.nz">www.tetotara.school.nz</a> or by visiting the School Office.

The Board will look at the number of enrolments, the level of projected student growth and determine how many spaces for out-of-zone students are available for the upcoming enrolment period of **16th December**, **2022 to 30th June**, **2023**. This will be completed in mid October, allowing for lots of time for families to know what is happening. Further information around the number of out-of-zone spaces to be released will be communicated via the school newsletter over the next few weeks.

Students will need to look their best, so please ensure that ONLY our correct school uniform is worn and that it is in a <u>clean and tidy condition</u> (black school shorts/skort, red polo shirt and red polar fleece).

Soon after Photo Day your son or daughter will bring home an online slip with their unique Shoot Key detailed on it. When you log-in your personalised Shoot Key number will display all the photographs of your child including an individual photo (and sibling photo if you have ordered one).

It is then an easy process for you to shop online and purchase the photographs you want. If you place your order within three weeks of receiving your Shoot Key you will receive free delivery of your order to the school.

If you order after the 3 week free delivery period, a postage & handling fee per order will apply and orders will be sent to your home.

For families who do not wish to use the Photolife online system, order envelopes will be available from the School Office soon after Photo Day.

A Photolife flyer will go home today to the eldest child in each family.

#### SCHOOL ATTENDANCE & FAMILY HOLIDAYS TAKEN DURING TERM TIME

You may be aware from recent announcements from the Ministry of Education through media coverage that there is a lot of concern with the teaching profession and education widely regarding the falling rates of school attendance. Children who have regular attendance at school experience higher levels of curriculum progress and success. There is also a direct correlation between regular attendance and positive wellbeing in our learners. The Ministry of Education's definition of regular attendance is 90% or more of days the school is open for instruction that your child is here and learning, Every day counts! Currently just over 50% of all NZ school children attain regular attendance. We know the pandemic has caused widespread disruption with the need to stay home for family contacts however, when children are well, they need to be at school.

Prior to Covid this percentage has been falling throughout New Zealand, since 2017 to be exact. This is such a concern and schools are being asked to have plans and strategies in place to increase regular attendance. Our Board of Trustees and Leadership Team have agreed this will be part of our Te Totara Charter, Strategic and Annual Plan for 2023.

From time-to-time we have families who wish to take their children out of school for a family holiday during term time. A new "G" Attendance Code has been introduced by the Ministry of Education (MOE) to keep track of these "unjustified" absences.

"G" Code Definition as per the MOE: When a student is on a New Zealand or overseas holiday during the school term, the absence is unjustified. A parent's note does not provide justification.

Our school would prefer family holidays to be taken outside of term time, we have approx. 12 weeks of school holidays available each year to do so. We do appreciate there may be some circumstances beyond the control of families whereby children will need to be away during term time, in this instance simply notifying the teacher/school verbally that your family is going on holiday is not sufficient.

Our school procedure is to email the Principal with the dates your child/ren will be absent from school and the reason why. Your email will be acknowledged and as per Ministry of Education requirements the Attendance Register will be coded as a"G" during their absence from school. We regularly monitor student absence.

### **Waikato Community School of Music**

Saturday morning music classes

Enrolments are now open for Term Three 2022 at the Waikato Community School of Music. The first session is on <u>Saturday 30th July</u>. 
