NEW COVID-19 ISOLATION AND TESTING REQUIREMENTS

The COVID-19 Protection Framework (traffic lights) ended on 12 September 2022. Please note the new guidelines now apply to everyone:



- → If you develop COVID-19 symptoms <u>aet tested</u> immediately.
- → Only people who test positive for COVID-19 are required to isolate for seven days.
- → Household contacts are recommended to take a rapid antigen test (RAT) every day for five days and avoid contact with the person who has had COVID-19

Thanks so much to almost everyone who takes care around the school, on behalf of our children, many thanks. Some tips to make sure we have a safe school:

- Parking in Disabled car parks is **not** permitted at any time unless you have a current "Disabled Parking" permit on display in your vehicle. We have a number of families who legitimately require these carparks.
- If you are in the main car park, please don't double park as it causes a grid lock behind you from cars entering and exiting the school car park. If you are behind someone who does this please feel free to toot, we won't mind...
- Do not leave your vehicle if you are parked in the drop-off zone, this will allow for the continued flow of traffic.
- Please be extra careful when backing out of a parking space, there may be children behind you that you cannot see.
- The use of hand-held mobile phones is not permitted while driving.
- Please ensure your child fastens their seat belt before your vehicle starts moving.

Fees have now been loaded onto KINDO. This online system allows you to pay for our school's fees (Mathletics/Mathseeds, Voluntary School Donation, Lost Library Book Costs etc) and is also the ONLY way to register/pay for your child for sports teams.

OUT-OF-ZONE ENROLMENTS FOR 2023

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, full details of which are available on our school website by clicking the following link: www.tetotara.school.nz

The Board has determined the following places are likely to be available to out-of-zone students from 2023 onwards. Enrolment period of <u>16th December</u>, <u>2022</u> - <u>30th June</u>, <u>2023</u>:

25 places for New Entrants (whose 5th Birthday falls within the above enrolment period)

5 places for Year 1 students

1 place for a Year 2 student

15 places for Year 3 students

10 places for Year 4 students

For students seeking enrolment within the above enrolment period, the deadline for receipt of out-of-zone applications is **3.00pm Friday 23rd September**, **2022 (tomorrow)** and should be emailed to: receptionist@tetotara.school.nz

If a ballot for out-of-zone is required, it will be held on <u>Friday 14th October</u>, <u>2022</u>. Parents will be informed of the outcome by **Wednesday 19th October**, <u>2022</u>.


