NEW DATE!

END OF YEAR CELEBRATION -MONDAY 11TH DECEMBER AT 5.45PM (weather permitting)

This is our annual event to celebrate another great year at Te Totara. Here is some information to help make it a special event:

- It is a school event, so children need to be in a <u>clean and tidy uniform.</u>
 <u>Students must be at school by 5.45pm and meet their class at the back field</u>. Please leave your child with us; we will take care of them.
- Students will need to stay through the whole event.
- There will be very limited parking available at the school car park and none in the turning bay. It will be best to find a car park on a nearby street and walk.
- It is like a concert in a park so bring a picnic, a rug to sit on, something to eat and drink and enjoy a variety concert. You are welcome to come earlier than 5.45pm if you wish to eat with your child before the concert.
- We use the hill behind Ra and Earth as outdoor stages where children perform.
- Toilets are open in the Ra and Earth blocks.





- Pre-schoolers are welcome to use the playground away from the performers so they don't distract from the performance.
- Other children not involved in the school are asked to be respectful and if they want to play, then the court area is a good place. There are likely to be over 2500 people at the event so we strongly advise walking to the event.
- Please <u>NO umbrellas</u> as it blocks the view of people behind. Low set chairs only are advisable if needed and should be set up towards the sides and back of the field.
- **<u>NO dogs</u>** are allowed on our school grounds.
- We will have a "Paparazzi" section at the front for parents/caregivers of those performing to use to get a good photo.
- Notifications will be put on the school Facebook page, school app and the website.
- The event is weather dependent, so may be cancelled at the last moment, but we will do our best to let everyone know as early as possible.
- At the end of the event we will need to stagger people leaving due to Health & Safety, so please be prepared to wait a little time. Announcements will be made by our Principal to ensure everyone moves off safely.

Some points around our classes:

- We do realise that this is a time of change and that this can cause anxiety, it can also be viewed as an opportunity to experience new classmates and a teacher with a wonderful range of new skills
- We deliberately "mix up" our children so by the time they progress through the school they have been exposed to a wide range of their peer group, building valuable and important relationships within the year group cohort
- We do find that the first transition within the school i.e. Year 1 to Year 2 can cause some concern as the children may be with others that are unknown, similarly moving to a new area of the school. This is understandable and we ask that families support the move with a positive approach
- We do ask that if there are any issues around class placement that families support what is in place and if there are any challenges then liaise very early with the new teacher in 2024.
- If there are ongoing concerns then please feel free to contact School Leaders after three weeks of the new school year which allows for the child to settle in and build valuable relationships
- Any requests to change a class from now on is highly likely to be declined as a class change can create a "knock on" effect and not give an opportunity to the child to take on the challenge of a new teacher and make the most of this new opportunity

End-of-Year Borrowing

Our library will be closed over the summer holidays. We encourage you to visit and issue books from any of the Hamilton City Libraries instead (the closest are Rototuna and Chartwell Libraries).

We are **open for end-of-year borrowing** and there are two ways to do this:

- 1. The library is open every morning from 8.15am-9am until the end of term so that parents/guardians can borrow books for their children, or
- 2. You can complete <u>this form</u> that gives permission for your child to borrow six books over the school holidays.

To borrow books students **must be returning to the school next year** and have no outstanding invoices or overdue library books. All books are due back by Friday 9 February (the end of the second week back at school).

Holiday Reading

Over the holidays, students can experience the "summer slump". This is a loss in reading achievement over summer if students stop reading. Providing some fun reading experiences during the holidays can help prevent the summer slump. Here are a few ways to encourage children to read:

- Participate in Hamilton City Libraries' free Summer Reading Programme (from December 18th)
- Read aloud to your child. It is the single most important activity for building the knowledge required for their own success in reading. It stimulates their imagination and improves their language and listening skills.
- Encourage your child to read anything the TV guide, magazines, joke books, recipes, travel guides, video game instructions...
- Find a series for your child to get hooked on. This will make choosing their next book to read easier. A recent survey showed that the primary factor in choosing a book for 7-12 year-olds was a familiar character or series.
- Find books that match your child's interests e.g. arts and crafts, skateboarding, cooking, animals.
- Read graphic novels. These comic books can be really appealing for children.
- Give your child a choice between going to bed or having an 'extra' half hour to read.



LEAVING TE TOTARA PRIMARY SCHOOL?

A notice regarding ezlunch / KINDO School Shop



If you are leaving your current school, here's some information to make your changeover streamlined:

If your family is leaving our school and has been using ezlunch or KINDO, please make sure to stop any regular automatic payments that have been set up before the school year finishes. You may also need to transfer or close your account which can be done as follows:

- Not sure if your new school is using KINDO? If you're not sure if your new school is using KINDO, you can either ask them directly or go to "*My Details*" in your KINDO account and click on the list of schools to see if your new school is listed.
- New school <u>IS</u> using KINDO. If your new school is using KINDO, simply click on the new school from the list in "*My Details*" of your KINDO account and you'll be attached to the new school's menu. Any balance on your KINDO account will remain available to spend with the new school.
- New school is <u>NOT</u> using KINDO, or you no longer need KINDO. If you need to close your KINDO account, use the "Close Account" button within the "My Details" section of your KINDO account. You can either withdraw your account balance or choose to donate your balance to the school. Please note that all withdrawals will be made via electronic payment to your New Zealand bank account. KINDO is unable to process cash withdrawals.
- If you are wanting to withdraw your KINDO account balance or make a donation that exceeds KINDO'S threshold (currently more than \$10,000 total within one year), KINDO may need to undertake some identity checks on you to comply with its obligations under the Anti-Money Laundering (AML) and Countering Financing of Terrorism (CFT) Act 2009. Please action the withdrawal or donation in your KINDO account as outlined above and if these AML checks are necessary KINDO will advise of the next steps required in this regard. KINDO has endeavoured to make this process as pain-free as possible and appreciates your patience.
