PINK SHIRT DAY (MUFTI DAY) - FRIDAY 16TH MAY, 2025



CONSULTATION ON THE RELATIONSHIP AND SEXUALITY CURRICULUM DRAFT DOCUMENT

The Ministry of Education has developed a draft framework for RSE that outlines what topics could be taught at each year of schooling.

The focus is on making sure the content is age-appropriate, evidence-informed, and clear about what is covered in RSE at each age, from Year 0 through to Year 13.

It is important that you know what is being taught and when, so you can have open conversations with your school and your child prior to this learning taking place. 


I Give My Kids Lines for Swearing!

Washing a kid's mouth out with soap is not a great approach — it's mean, it's a battle, and honestly, it's over way too quickly.




