


SCHOOL BOARD

ELECTIONS

All state and state-integrated schools are required to hold School Board elections every three years, and the next round will take place this year, in 2025.

The School Board is an important part of our school as they set the strategic direction for our school, consult with our school community about our school,



Our School Board is made up of 5x Parent Representatives, the Principal and 1x Staff Representative (elected by staff).

The current School Board has appointed **Election Pilot** as our Returning Officer, and the election will be conducted online. They have been assisting schools with elections for over 20 years and have been the only election provider accredited by the Ministry of Education to provide online election services since online elections started in 2022.

Nomination and voting forms will be sent to all eligible voters by email directly from Election Pilot. If we don't have an email address for you, nomination and voting papers will be sent by post so no one will miss out.

School Board Elections must be held in accordance with the provisions in the Education and Training Act 2020 and the Education (Board Elections) Regulations 2022. Your name and contact details have been provided to the Schooled Election Pilot to enable the provision of election services for our school as required by legislation.

They will use your contact details for the provision of election services for Te Totara Primary School only and your details will be deleted 60 days after the election date as required by legislation. If you have any questions about the election process, please contact the Returning Officer directly on **0800 VOTENZ (0800 868 369)** or via email: **election@electionpilot.nz** 

We will continue to keep you updated through the various stages of the election process. Our election date is **Wednesday 10th September**, **2025**.
