SCHOOL HOLIDAY READING

Over the holidays students can experience the "summer slump." This is a loss in reading achievement over summer if children stop reading.

Providing some fun reading experiences during the holidays can help prevent the summer slump. Here are a few ways to get children reading:

- Read aloud to your child. It is the single most important activity for building the knowledge required for their own success in reading. It stimulates their imagination and improves their language and listening comprehension skills.
- Encourage your child to read anything the TV guide, magazines, joke books, recipes, travel guides, video game instructions...
- Find a series for your child to get hooked on. This will make choosing the next book to read easier. A recent survey showed that the primary factor in choosing a book for 7 – 12 year olds was a familiar character or series.
- Find books that match your child's interests arts and crafts, skateboarding, cooking, animals...
